BACKGROUND:

<u>Summary</u>

The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) owns certain real property referred to as Mont Blanc Drive in the unincorporated Lake Hills Area, County of Riverside, State of California (Property). In 2021, the Riverside County Board of Supervisors approved Resolution No. 2021-154, Riverside County's Transportation and Land Management summarily vacating Mont Blanc Drive conveying the Property fee interests to the District.

The District owns the adjacent parcel to the north, Lot F, that is associated with the Arizona Channel. The Property is vacant and non-maintained and is not needed for the nearby Arizona Channel facility. The District desires to declare the Property as exempt surplus land and dispose of the Property. The adjacent property owners to the south Lot 1, Richard and Nancy Hopkins, Trustees of the Hopkins Family Trust, dated March 5, 2021, have expressed an interest in purchasing the surplus land.

Pursuant to the California Water Code Appendix Ch. 48, Section 9, the District's Board of Supervisors (Board) has the power to take by grant, purchase, gift, devise, or lease, or otherwise, to hold, use, enjoy, and to lease or dispose of real, personal, or mixed property of every kind within or without the District necessary or convenient to the full exercise of its powers, and to lease its property to public agencies, or to grant any interest therein to public agencies, which lease or grant does not interfere with the use of the property for the purposes of the District.

Pursuant to the California Water Code Appendix Ch. 48, Section 13, the Board may determine any real property held by the District is no longer necessary to be retained for the uses and purposes thereof and may thereafter sell or otherwise dispose of said Property or lease the same.

The Property is exempt surplus land under the California Surplus Land Act, pursuant to Government Code Section 54221(f)(1)(E), because the Property is former right of way being conveyed to an adjacent property owner.

Therefore, the District recommends that the Property known as Mont Blanc Drive in the unincorporated Lake Hills Area, County of Riverside, should now be declared exempt surplus land and no longer necessary for the District's needs pursuant to California Water Code – Appendix, Chapter 48, Sections 48-9 and 48-13.

Resolution No. F2022-03 has been approved as to form by County Counsel.

This fee interest of Mont Blanc Drive in the unincorporated Lake Hills Area, County of Riverside, will be granted by the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District when the Board meets to conclude the proposed transaction on March 1, 2022, at 9:30 a.m. or soon thereafter, at the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors.






