- **The vacation of Caravel Lane has rendered Cibola Circle into a dead-end road that has no turnabout, turnout or even a fire hydrant.**
- **Cibola Circle is a 650' feet long road that is less than 24' wide in some areas,** due to encroachments that are in the roadway. Those encroachments were put in by the property owner (Michael Noel) that had requested the vacation of Caravel Lane.
- Those encroachments in Cibola Circle were reported to RIVCO officials. A copy of the encroachment survey report done by a CA State licensed surveyor at the Boers' expense was provided to RIVCO Transportation. However no one in RIVCO would do anything about this, thus allowing for a dangerous situation on Cibola Circle, rendering it less than 24' wide in some areas.
- Some of the folks that had opposed the vacation of Caravel Lane asked the RIVCO BoS to consider conditional approving the vacation with the condition that a turnabout goes in at Cibola Circle using some of the Public Land to be vacated.
- U.S. Army Master Sergeant (Ret.) Chuck Boers has come back to the RIVCO BoS meeting numerous times to show that there is a need for at least a turnabout on Cibola and how the vacation of Caravel Lane was improperly handled by the RIVCO Transportation .
- **Part of Caravel Lane that was vacated could have been used for a turnabout.**
- **The RIVCO BoS have the authority to amend the vacation of Caravel Lane to reflect that a full turnabout needs to be put in on Cibola Circle using some of the Public Land that was freely given to Public Servant and their Family.**

- RIVCO Director of Transportation Mark Lancaster did a presentation to the RIVCO BoS during the vacation hearing Caravel Lane. During that presentation Lancaster present many false, misleading statements, or not factual accurate information to the RIVCO BoS.
- Prior to the RIVCO Planning Commision and RIVCO BoS hearings for Caravel Lane hard factual information and hard evidence was provided to Lancaster and his department by those opposed to the vacation of Caravel Lane. For example some of that information provided was the working and fully functional fire hydrant at the conner of Caravel Lane and Valencia, that was confirmed by the Rancho California Water Authority. Lancaster had stated that during the BoS meeting that there was no fire hydrant along the area to be vacated.
- RIVCO BoS on several occasions have been presented hard facts of those false, misleading statements made by Lancaster during the vacation hearing of Caravel Lane to the RIVCO BoS.
- My next two slides will show how some RIVCO employees and RIVCO public servants did not uphold their duties during the process for the vacation of Caravel Lane and possibly violated some of the RIVCO Ethical Conduct Standards.
- RIVCO Ethical Conduct Standards: Public's Interest, Dedication, Policy Makers, Public Awareness, Honesty, Integrity, Trustworthiness, Fairness, Concern for Others, Law Abiding, Commitment to Excellence, Leadership, Reputation and Morale, Accountability.
- When RIVCO employees and RIVCO public servants violate these RIVCO Ethical Conduct Standards and are not held fully accountable, then the public will not have faith or trust in their local government or public officials carrying out their official duties in a professional, transparent and honest manner.

- **Megan Kavand, a RIVCO Senior Financial Analyst, used her official RIVCO Transportation Commission email to communicate with other RIVCO agencies to facilitate the vacation of Caravel Lane, which would benefit Kavand and her family that resides along the area to be vacated.**
- **Paul Hillmer, a RIVCO Senior Land Surveyor, who was responsible for processing the Caravel Lane vacation packet was asked during a sworn deposition if he knew Megan Kavand. Hillmer said, "no he did not know Kavand."** It should also be noted that RIVCO has not done a private vacation in more than a decade.
- **After Hillmer made that statement under oath, Hillmer was presented an email that showed he not only had email contact with Kavand, but phone conversations as well.** RIVCO County Counsel was present during that sworn deposition and a copy was provided to RIVCO BoS Chuck Washington's Staff prior to the BoS public hearing for the vacation of Caravel Lane.
- **Both Hillmer and Kavand were working together on the vacation process for Caravel Lane. A vacation that would benefit Kavand and her family in a FREE GIFT of PUBLIC LAND.**
- **The letter Lancaster read to the RIVCO BoS during the vacation hearing of Caravel Lane wasn't any random letter, it was from Megan Kavand, who has worked with Lancaster on projects. Lancaster cherry picked a line from full page letter, which was taken out of context, and Lancaster read, "all Mr. Boers wants to do is walk across their property."**
- **However when a RIVCO BoS member asked who the letter was from, Lancaster replied it was from the applicants daughter. Lancaster wasn't dishonest in his answer about who the letter was from, but Lancaster wasn't being fully transparent with BoS and the Public in his answer either.** I provided a copy of Kavand's letter (along with other information) in a packet that was given to all the RIVCO BoS during a previous BoS Public hearing.

Hi Paul,

I just spoke with Steve from Fire and he was unaware that the CSA had recently improved Cibola Circle. The road was realigned to the west, widened to 30', smoothed and had DG placed. Additionally the gate obstructing Cibola Circle was removed approximately a year and a half ago in anticipation of the CSA improvement. This satisfies bullets 2 - 4. In order to satisfy the first bullet, I have emailed Stella to start the process of changing the address from Caravel to Cibola. Our intent was to do this once we got a bit further along with the vacate but I will start on this now. If/when the vacation is approved, the address will be updated.

Here are the Fire Departments concerns as they were relayed to me:

- Existing address is off of Caravel Lane, address will need to be changed to Cibola Circle.
- Access to Cibola Circle will need to be improved (all weather road) from Alta Mesa for emergency equipment.
- Fence along east side of Cibola Circle will need to be removed to provide 24' of unobstructed access.
- Any gates obstructing access on Cibola Circle will need a KNOX key switch or KNOX padlock provided for emergency access.

Please let me know when Fire's concerns have been addressed. Once we get the revised legal description and plat back the next step is to send out letters to surrounding property owners seeking their feedback. Once Fire's concerns have been addressed and we get community responses back we will share the results with you and can formulate the plan forward. The final decision on Vacations is made by the Board of Supervisors. Applying for a Vacation is not a guarantee that the Board will approve.

In just these three emails (which is just one example of many) shows Kavand and Hillmer worked together on the vacation of Caravel Lane. Kavand as a RIVCO Public Servant used her official email (as well as phone calls) and title to correspond with other agencies to push through the vacation of Caravel Lane, which resulted in Kavand and her family receiving a FREE GIFT of Public Land. The vacation of Caravel Lane resulted in Cibola Circle becoming a dead-end road with no Public turnabout.

- The RIVCO BoS on several occasions have been presented videos that clearly show that there is a need for a turnabout on Cibola Circle.
- Any reasonable person would expect to be able to turnaround easily on a dead-end public road and not having to do a four to six point turn to get out or backup the whole 650' length of Cibola Circle.
- There is a safety factor that should be considered as well. Cibola Circle is a 650' long road that isn't even 24' wide in some areas.
- Our first responders and other public servants should not be hindered in their duties because there is no turnabouts, turnouts, or even a fire hydrant at the end of Cibola Circle.
- Bottomline I'm here today to ask the RIVCO BoS to either consider rescinding their decision to vacate Caravel Lane or amend their decision and require a full public turnabout go on Cibola Circle with the public land (Caravel Lane) that was vacated.
- The RIVCO BoS has the opportunity to bring Cibola Circle up to standards by requiring as a minimum a turnabout with a fire hydrant and removing the encroachments.
