4. Approve the project proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A".



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated November 16, 2021 (Agenda Item 3.29), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors (Board) authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the Construction of all legs of the existing roundabout located at the intersection of Rancho California Road and Anza Road approximately 0.5 miles in the Community of Rancho California of Riverside County.

The roadway reconstruction is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. The work will include removing existing asphalt concrete and underlying material and place back new Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) concrete pavement over aggregate base with geotextile placed between the pavement and aggregated base, and between the aggregate base and natural soil to provide subgrade enhancement thus preventing premature failure of pavement structure.

Additional improvements include paving a temporary hot mix asphalt roadway, placement of AC dike, reconstruction of curb and gutter and concrete curbs, pavement safety edge, placing of traffic striping, thermoplastic crosswalk and pavement markings, and other associated work.

The work will be done during seven-days full closure of the intersection with 24 hours shifts to excavate, scarify, moisture condition, compact, and pave the road followed by seven working days to complete additional associated work shown on the plans and specified in the contract documents. Traffic will be detoured through Calle Contento, Pauba Road, De Portola Road and Glen Oak Road for commuters traveling to the west, east and south leg of the roundabout. A temporary roadway will be constructed on private property for commuters and residents needing to access the northerly leg of the roundabout.

During the advertisement, period one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addendum on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The addendum is attached herewith and designated as Addendum No. 1.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB-1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The Rancho California Road and Anza Road Reconstruction Project is one of the County of Riverside's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. Without SB-1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The bid proposal included one base bid schedule for Rancho California Road and Anza Road Reconstruction, and three alternative bid schedules belong to Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD), Frontier, and Metropolitan Water District (MWD) for utilities adjustments. EMWD, Frontier, and MWD did not concur with the bid prices proposed by All American Asphalt. Therefore, the contract will include base bid schedule only, and the work associated with EMWD, Frontier, and MWD will be done with their own forces.

The contractor, All American Asphalt is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Project No. D0-0068

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt for approximate 0.5 miles between all four legs of the Rancho California and Anza Road roundabout to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic. The work is scheduled to begin spring 2022 and will be completed within approximately three weeks.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in FY 2021/2022 within three weeks and will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 and Developer Contribution.

The proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A" includes Contract award amount and other associated costs. There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Six bids were received on Wednesday December 8, 2021 ranging from \$1,049,260 to \$1,677,000. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by All American Asphalt in the amount of 1,049,260 however, the contract amount without alternative bid schedules will be \$1,031, 660 which is \$33,525 (3.15%) below the Engineer's Estimate of \$1,065,185.

Bidders are directed to sign this addendum as acknowledged and attach the signed addendum to the contractor's submitted proposal.

MODIFICATIONS / CLARIFICATIONS TO SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

Item 1: 00-1.03 Time of Completion

Refer to Section "00-1.03 Time of Completion" on [page 2](#) of the Special Provisions. The third and fourth paragraphs are deleted and replaced with the following and made part thereof.

The County will allow a maximum of seven (7) calendar days of full road closure on Rancho California Road and Anza Road within the project limits during the period between March 20, 2022 and March 26, 2022 only. The contractor will be permitted to close the roads and roundabout, weather permitting, beginning on Sunday March 20, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. and must reopen roundabout seven (7) days later by Saturday March 26, 2022 at 6:00 p.m.

There are significant liquidated damages for each 15-minute increment in excess of the time specified for reopening of closure.

The contractor will be allowed to begin work without closure at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday March 20, 2022 and continue working without closure till 6:00 p.m. Additionally, the contractor will be allowed to continue working without closure between 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. on Saturday March 26, 2022.

Item 2: 00-1.03(A) Modified Hours of Work

Refer to Section "00-1.03(A) Modified Hours of Work" on [page 2](#) of the Special Provisions. The third paragraph is deleted and replaced with the following and made part thereof.

During the 7 Calendar (Consecutive) Days, working hours shall be between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Sunday March 20, 2022 for work not requiring full closure of roads, 24-hours after full road closures are implemented at 6:00 p.m. on Sunday March 20, 2022 through 6:00 p.m. on Saturday March 26, 2022, and between 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. on Saturday March 26, 2022 for work not requiring full closure of roads.

Item 3: 39-2.08 Temporary Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Pavement

Refer to Section "39-2.08 Temporary Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Pavement" on [page 52](#) of the Special Provisions. The last paragraph on page 52 is deleted and replaced with the following and made part thereof.

Temporary pavement delineation will be required and shall conform to Section 12-6, Temporary Pavement Delineation, of the Standard Specifications, and as directed by the Engineer. The temporary pavement delineation shall be done with painted striping in conformance with Temporary Detour Road Exhibit. Full compensation for Temporary Pavement Delineation shall be considered as included in the contract price paid per lump sum for Traffic Control System and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

MODIFICATIONS / CLARIFICATIONS TO THE PLANS

Item 4: Plan sheet revisions.

Refer to Plan Sheets L-1 through L-4 (sheets 3 through 6 of 11). These sheets have been deleted and replaced with the revised sheets L-1 through L-4 and attached herewith as **Attachment "A"**.

Plan revisions consist of "Caution" note and delineation of existing storm drain lines.

In addition, refer to Plan Sheet L-4 (sheet 6 of 11). The Contractor is hereby cautioned that at around station 20+90.00+/- Anza Road, there is a Rancho California Water District's water valve that has a buried concrete collar around the slip can which may require additional effort to adjust to grade. No additional compensation will be allowed for utility adjustment. The valve is called out on the plans to be adjusted to grade by the contractor.

Item 5: Temporary Detour Road Exhibit.

Temporary Detour Road Exhibit is incorporated and made a part hereby for the construction of the temporary asphalt concrete roadway on private property necessary to detour vehicles traveling from eastbound Rancho California Road to northbound Anza Road (or southbound Anza Road to westbound Rancho California Road). See Temporary Detour Road Exhibit attached herewith as **Attachment "B"**.

Item 6: Conceptual Traffic Handling and Detour Plan.

Conceptual Traffic Handling and Detour Plan(s) is being provided and attached herewith as **Attachment "C"**.

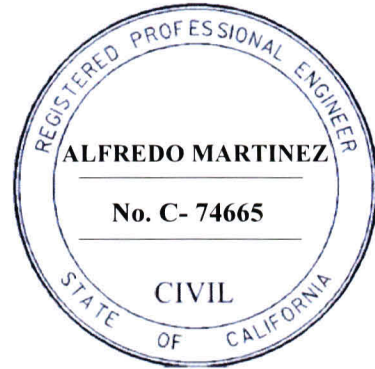

Recitals:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, Rancho California Road and Anza Road Reconstruction Project, Community of Rancho California, Project No. D0-0068, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders, (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of 2018 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda (one) , (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.04, "Start of Job Site Activities", Section 8-1.05, "Time", and in Section 8-1.10 "Liquidated Damages" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within fifteen (15) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.
