BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface approximately 1.5 miles of Mountain View Road from Dillon Road to the City limit of Desert Hot Springs in the Community of Southeast Desert Hot Springs of Riverside County.

Mountain View Road is classified as an arterial road in the County of Riverside General Plan. Mountain View Road is a two-lane road that varies between 24 feet to 58 feet in width.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. Mainly, the Mountain View Road Resurfacing Project will consist of two types of treatment.

Mountain View Road Limits	Treatment Type	
From Dillon Road to 1.2 miles north of Dillon Road	Grind asphalt concrete in place and overlay with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA).	
From 1.2 miles north of Dillon Road to City of Desert Hot Springs limit	Remove existing asphalt concrete and underlying material and place back HMA.	

Additional improvements include placement of AC dike, reconstruction of asphalt concrete driveways, reconstruction of sidewalk, curb and gutter, cross gutter and spandrels, concrete driveways, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant curb ramps, construction of retaining wall, placement of safety edge and shoulder backing to protect the outside edge of pavement, placing of traffic striping, thermoplastic crosswalk, pavement markings, replacing existing guardrail, reconstruction of existing overside drains, upgrading existing traffic signal at Mountain View Road and Dillon Road from a loop detection system to a video detection system and other associated work.

SUBMITTAL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB-1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Mountain View Road resurfacing project is one of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. Without SB-1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

Mountain View Road Resurfacing

Alternative Bid 1:

City of Desert Hot Springs Portion

Alternative Bid 2:

Mission Springs Water District (MSWD) Facilities Adjustments

Alternative Bid 3:

MSWD Facilities Adjustments (City Portion)

Improvements within the City of Desert Hot Springs are included in the bid package as an alternate bid schedule. If the City of Desert Hot Springs approves the award of their alternate bid schedule, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by the City of Desert Hot Springs through a reimbursement Agreement, which will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval prior to or concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

The adjustment of the facilities owned by MSWD, are also included in the bid package as an alternative bid schedule. If MSWD approve the award of their alternative bid schedule, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by the utility owner through a reimbursement letter Agreement that will be executed by the Director of Transportation.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid for the sum of all bid schedules.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt for the approximate 1.5 miles segment of Mountain View Road to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin spring 2022. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,630,610. The County improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 Funds. The City of Desert Hot Springs and MSWD are responsible for funding their respective alternative bid schedules in full if approved.





- Pulverizing the roadway and overlaying with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA)
- Upgrading the existing traffic signal at Dillon Room from loop detection to camera detection
- Replacing existing guardrail to meet current Caltrans standards
- Reconstructing existing curb ramps to meet ADA standards
- Reconstructing existing overside drains using concreted-rock slopes
- Utility adjustments
- Vegetation removal
- Salvage/removal and installation of new signs

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed improvements will be constructed within existing County right-of-way. Temporary construction easements may be required.




