5. Approve the project proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A".



BACKGROUND:

By Minute Order dated November 09, 2021 (Agenda Item 3.15), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Carver Tract Sidewalk Safety Improvement Project. The proposed project will construct sidewalk improvements along the following segments:

- South side of Leyte Avenue between Van Buren Street and Luzon Street
- North side of Corregidor Avenue between Van Buren Street and Luzon Street
- North side of Lingayen Avenue between Van Buren Street and Luzon Street
- West side of Luzon Street between 48th Avenue and Leyte Avenue

Additional improvements include widen each roadway, install concrete curb and gutter, curb ramps, and drainage improvements. The proposed improvements will provide a fully American with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessible all weather pathway for pedestrians.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addendum on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The addendum is attached herewith and designated as Addendum No. 1.

The contract includes the following schedule of work:

Base Bid Schedule:	Carver Tract Sidewalks Project and associated work
Alternate Bid Schedule:	Facilities Adjustments for Valley Sanitary District (VSD)

VSD has accepted the bid prices proposed by S&H Civilworks for alternative bid schedule 1, and the cost for the work will be reimbursed by VSD through a reimbursement agreement. The Director of Transportation has the authority to sign reimbursement agreements up to \$100,000 per Minute Order dated November 19, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.25).

The contractor, S&H Civilworks, is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed improvements will enhance pedestrian safety and provide an ADA compliant path. In addition to the residents along the project limits, there are several community facilities providing goods and services to local residents that are within walking distance of the project and will be served by the project improvements including: Martin Van Buren Elementary School, New Seasons Church, Coachella Valley Rescue Mission, Coachella Valley Wild Bird Center, Riverside County Office of Education, Rancho Las Flores Park, and the United Families/Fred Young Farm Labor Center.

The work is scheduled to begin in spring 2022 and will take approximately three and a half months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in FY 2022/2023 and will be funded with SB 821 (Local Transportation Funds), Gas Tax/HUTA and Valley Sanitary District funds.

The proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A" includes Contract award amount and other associated costs.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Ten bids were received on Wednesday December 1, 2021 ranging from \$1,462,416 to \$2,419,480. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Baltazar Construction Inc. (Baltazar) was announced as the apparent low bidder when bids were received. A Notice of Acceptance and Intent to Award letter was sent to Baltazar on December 13, 2021 (see Attachment), in which the Contractor was requested to return, within ten working days, the executed construction contract, performance bond, payment bond, and evidence of insurance as required in the contract documents.

After the expiration of the prescribed document submittal period as set forth in the Instruction to Bidders, Section 20, Baltazar did not provide the contract document submittals. The Transportation Department was notified by phone that contract documents would not be submitted when contract documents were due. The Transportation Department notified Baltazar

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by phone and email that their bid would not be accepted. Additionally, the Transportation Department sent a letter dated January 28, 2022, to notify Baltazar regarding the County's action to rescind the Intent to Award issued to their company, select the second low bidder to award this contract, and make a claim against Baltazar's bid bond as set forth in the bid documents for damages in the amount of the difference between Baltazar's bid and the next low bidder's bid amount (see Attachment).

Due to the lack of response from the low bidder consistent with the Instructions to Bidders, Section 20, the Transportation Department recommends that the County Board of Supervisors find the low bidder non-compliant with the bid documents and reject its low bid. Public Contract Code section 5106 states, "[i]f the public entity deems it is for its best interest, it may, on refusal or failure of the successful bidder to execute the contract, award it to the second lowest bidder." The Transportation Department further recommends that the second low bid, which was submitted by the firm of S&H Civilworks be accepted and that the contract be awarded to that firm.

The next lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by the second low bidder, S&H Civilworks in the amount of \$1,514,950. This bid is \$ 3,580 (0.24%) less than the Engineer's Estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to S&H Civilworks in the amount of \$1,514,950.

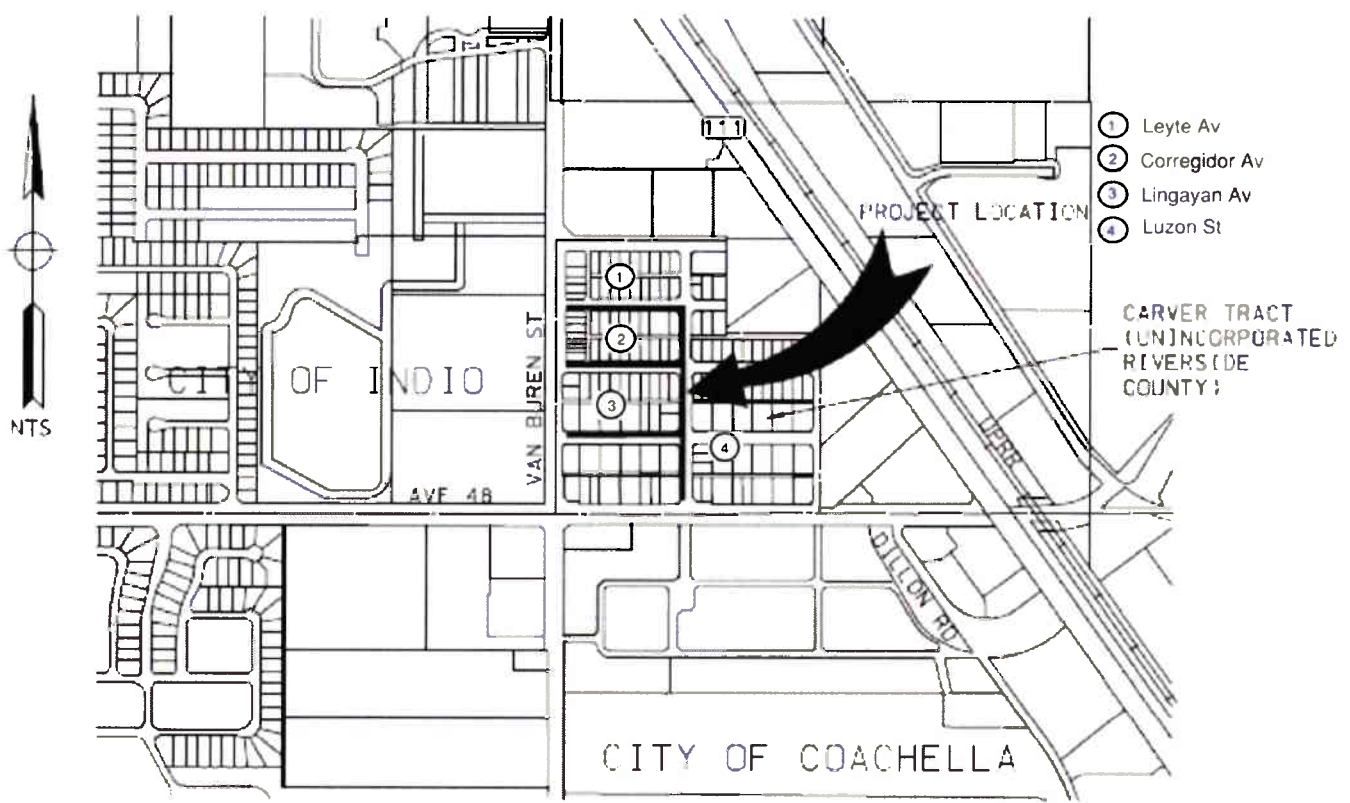
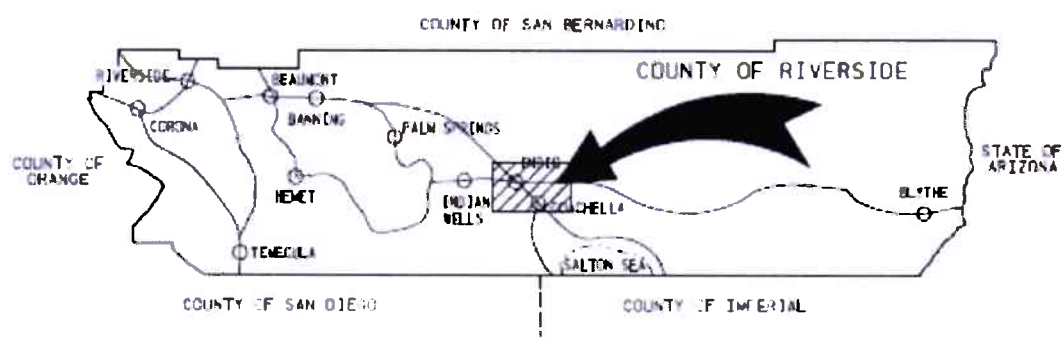

Approval of Closure Schedule amendments will be at the discretion of the Engineer.

Portable Changeable Message Signs shall be posted two (2) weeks prior to start of road closure to notify residents and motorist.

The Engineer shall be notified of cancelled closures two (2) business days before the date of closure.

Closures that are cancelled due to unsuitable weather may be rescheduled at the discretion of the Engineer.

LATE REOPENING OF CLOSURES:

If a closure is not reopened to public traffic by the specified time, work shall be suspended. No further closures are to be made until the Engineer has accepted a work plan submitted by the Contractor that will ensure that future closures will be reopened to public traffic at the specified time. The Engineer will have two (2) business days to accept or reject the Contractor's proposed work plan. The Contractor will not be entitled to compensation for the suspension of work resulting from the late reopening of closures.

This is to notify you that the County of Riverside is rescinding the Notice of Acceptance of Proposal and Intent to Award issued to your company on December 13, 2021. This letter was electronically delivered via e-mail, and printed original documents were also delivered to your office by FedEx on December 14, 2021.

Your company Baltazar Construction, Inc. (Baltazar) submitted the apparent low bid for the subject project on December 1, 2021. After reviewing the bid proposal, the County of Riverside Transportation Department (Department) considered Baltazar's bid to be responsive. After Notice of Acceptance of Proposal and Intent to Award, your company submitted insurance certificate via email on December 16, 2021 and later we received a mailed printed copy. However, contracts and bonds were not received by our office. The Contracts, Performance Bonds and Payment Bonds were due December 28, 2021.

Please refer to Instruction to Bidder's Section 20, Award of Contract, subsections "A" and "C".

"A. A Bidder whose Bid is accepted must execute the formal construction Contract with the County, similar to the form attached hereto as a sample, and must return said Contract, together with approved Performance Bond and Payment Bond and with complete evidence of insurance as required elsewhere herein, including executed additional insured endorsements and waivers of subrogation, within ten (10) business days from the date of the Notice of Acceptance of Bid and Intent to Award as issued by the Transportation Department."

"C. If a Bidder to whom a Notice of Acceptance of Bid and Intent to Award has been issued, fails or refuses to sign a construction Contract, or to furnish the bonds or insurance certificates and endorsements as required within the prescribed period of time as described above, the County may, at its sole discretion, rescind the Notice of Acceptance, and the bid guarantee submitted by that Bidder will become the property of the County as prescribed in the bid documents and as allowed by law."

Baltazar requested by phone on December 28, 2021 to be relieved from its bid primarily due to lack of available staff necessary to perform the work. Baltazar then followed up with a letter dated December 30, 2021 (attached) requesting relief from its bid. Unfortunately, that is not proper grounds for being relieved of bid. Public Contract Code (PCC) sections 5101 and 5103 permit an awarding authority to relieve a bidder of its bid because of a mistake. The Department concludes that the actions and information provided by Baltazar does not meet the requirements of PCC 5101 and 5103 since written notice of the mistake was not provided within five working days after the opening of the bids.


Nevertheless, Transportation Department will proceed with Rescission of Notice of Acceptance and Intent to Award because your company has demonstrated non responsiveness in not providing executed contract documents.

PCC section 5106 states, *"if the public entity deems it is for its best interest, it may, on refusal or failure of the successful bidder to execute the contract, award it to the second lowest bidder."*

The County intends to proceed to award to the next low bidder and make a claim against your company's bid bond, as set forth in the bid documents, in the amount of the difference between your company's bid and the next low bidder's bid amount for all bidding schedules.

Dear Mr. Jimenez,

I am respectfully requesting relief of bond on Project: Carver tract Sidewalk Safety Improvement Project Community of Carver Tract #D0-0020. On Monday December 27, 2021, we had a company meeting regarding the project referenced above. At this time, I was informed by our company foreman that he, our backhoe operator and one laborer would not be available to do this project due to its location. The employees expressed that they did not want to stay in a hotel for 4 nights a week, because they did not want to be away from their families. The project is estimated to take 70 working days, and that was too long for them. They expressed that they could find work elsewhere closer to home.

Later that morning, I was informed by my estimator that we did not have enough manpower to run several jobs at the same time, (I have nine field employees and one foreman) therefore there was not enough work for him, and he had obtained employment elsewhere. He also brought to my attention that he made **two significant typographical errors** on his bid. Line item 7) ROADWAY EXCAVATION: quantity is 2,650 CY, he typed in \$25 per CY, and it should have been \$55 per CY resulting in a \$79,500 error. Also, LINE ITEM 18) ADJUST WATER METER BOX TO GRADE AND INSTALL TRAFFIC RATED COVER quantity is 35 UNITS, he typed in \$450 per unit. It should have been \$750.00 per unit resulting in a \$10,500 error. Please see a copy of the bid he submitted attached.

Baltazar Construction has been in business since 2002. On January 31, 2021, our company President, and my husband of 40 years, passed away due to complications from COVID-19. At that time our company was under legal obligation to complete several contracts, which we did successfully. My intention was to carry on with the business for at least 5 more years, because I love this industry and it was a way of helping me process the loss of my husband. However, these unexpected turn of events have crippled my company, and I have made the decision to start the process to close my company doors.

I am grateful for the opportunity your city has given me, and I deeply regret that I must make this request and am relying on your understanding of my situation and hope you will consider not taking action against my bid bond. I was sincerely looking forward to doing the project and establishing mutually beneficial relationship. Thank you for your assistance.
