4. Direct the Clerk of the Board to cause a certified copy of this resolution to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of the County of Riverside, California.



BACKGROUND:

Summary:

Due to the construction of the 66th Avenue Railroad Grade Separation project, a portion of 66th Avenue, State Route 111 (SR111), and Lincoln Street have been realigned. The re-aligned portion of 66th Avenue between (SR111) and Grapefruit Boulevard (SR111) shall be named "66th Avenue SR111", the re-aligned portion of Lincoln Street between existing Lincoln Street and 66th Ave SR111 shall be named "Lincoln Street", and the portion of re-aligned roadway between 66th Ave SR111 Easterly to Dale Kiler Road shall be named "66th Avenue Bypass".

The right of way for those portions of Lincoln Street and 66th Ave SR111 whose alignments have been superseded and no longer serve as roadways shall be vacated in a separate action by the Board of Supervisors at a future date.

County Counsel has approved Resolution Number 2022-063 as to form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses:

The naming of the realigned portions will not impact the business owners or residents.

NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

Project Name: Resolution No. 2022-063, Naming of the Re-aligned Portions of 66th Avenue and Lincoln Street, in the Mecca Area.

Project Number: B80664D

Description of Project: Naming of the Re-aligned Portions of 66th Avenue and Lincoln Street in the Mecca Area.

Name of Public Agency Approving Project: Riverside County Transportation Department, Survey Division, County of Riverside.

Name of Person or Agency Carrying Out Project: David L. McMillan, Riverside County Transportation Department, Survey Division, County of Riverside.

Exempt Status: California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, Section 15061(b)(3), General Rule "Common Sense" Exemption. Not a "project" as defined under State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15060(c).


Reasons Why Project is Exempt: Changing the name of a street has been determined to not be a "project" as defined under State CEQA Guidelines section 15060(c). However, even if it was determined to be a project under CEQA for analysis purposes, the project is exempt from the provisions of CEQA specifically by the State CEQA Guidelines as identified below. The renaming of the existing roadway will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of the categorical exemption as detailed under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2. The project will not cause any impacts to scenic resources, historic resources, or unique sensitive environments. Further, no unusual circumstances or potential cumulative impacts would occur that may reasonably create an environmental impact. Changing the name of this street will not have an effect on the environment; thus, the County has deemed this does not meet the definition of a "project" under CEQA and no environmental impacts are anticipated to occur.

- Section 15061(b)(3) - General Rule "Common Sense" Exemption. With certainty, there is no possibility that the proposed project may have a significant effect on the environment. The renaming of a street will not require any construction activities, change the use or intensity of the existing site to create a physical environmental impact, and would not lead to any direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical environmental impacts. Therefore, in no way would changing the name of a street have the potential to cause a significant environmental impact and the vacation is exempt from further CEQA analysis.

- Section 15060(c) – for purposes of analysis under CEQA, changing the name of a street is not a “project” under CEQA pursuant to Section 15060(c). An action by a public agency is only a “project” subject to CEQA if the action might result in a physical change in the environment. Based upon a review of the whole action undertaken, supported, or authorized by the County, in no way will changing the name of a street increase the use of the site, result in increased development or construction impacts, or lead to any direct, indirect, or cumulative physical environmental impacts.

Based upon the identified exemptions above, the County of Riverside hereby concludes that no physical environmental impacts are anticipated to occur and the project as proposed is exempt under CEQA. No further environmental analysis is warranted.

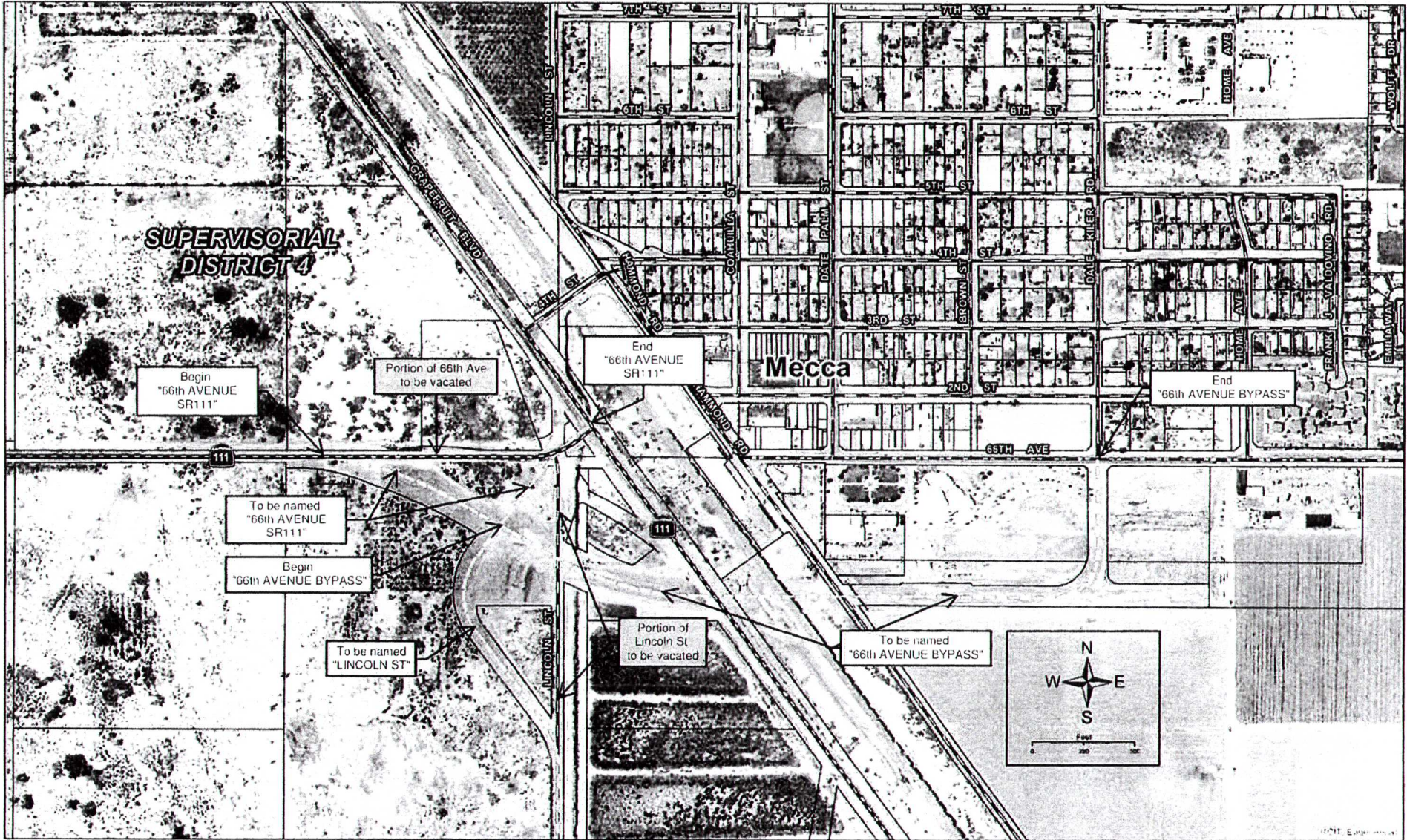
