

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. March Field Air Museum donation will be used to support the programs and community events such as the Champions of Flight 2022 and the Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans event. The museum offers the opportunity for the community to experience and learn the history of military and civil aviation.
2. Riverside University Health System Foundation donation will be used to help promote child abuse awareness as well as equipment and resources for the Riverside County Child Assessment Team (RCCAT). The Pinwheels for Prevention Campaign is continuing the effort to help raise awareness and support prevention efforts on behalf of all children who are suffering from abuse and neglect.
3. Banning Pass Little League donation will support the youth baseball and softball needs such as necessary equipment, helmets, safety gear and field maintenance to have a safe and successful season.
4. Riverside County District Attorney's Office, Division of Victim Services donation will be used to support outreach and awareness to the public by hosting events throughout the County for National Crime Victims' Rights Week as well as the engraving of the victim's name on the memorial wall.
5. Perris Valley Filipino-American Association, Inc. donation will provide support for cultural advancement and preservation of the organization along with community outreach in behavioral health awareness and community events.
