2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Rainbow Canyon Road Resurfacing Project, in the Community of Rainbow;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, April 13, 2022 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface approximately 1 mile of Rainbow Canyon Road from Frontage Road to the City of Temecula boundary line in the Community of Rainbow of Riverside County.

Rainbow Canyon Road is classified a secondary highway in the County of Riverside's General Plan. Rainbow Canyon Road is currently 26 feet wide with two lanes that travel in the north-south directions.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. Mainly, the proposed Rainbow Canyon Road Resurfacing Project will consist of two treatment types. The first treatment consists of grinding down a portion of the pavement followed by overlaying back with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) on an approximately 0.4 miles segment of roadway. The second treatment will clean, crack seal, and tack coat an approximately 0.6 mile segment of roadway prior to overlaying the existing asphalt with HMA.

Additional improvements include placement of AC dike, reconstruction of asphalt concrete driveways, concrete driveways, placement of safety edge and shoulder backing to protect the outside edge of pavement, placing of traffic striping, pavement markings, replacing existing guardrail, and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB-1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Rainbow Canyon Road Resurfacing Project is one of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. Without SB-1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

Base Bid Schedule: Rainbow Canyon Road Resurfacing and associated improvements  
Alternative Bid 1: Lumen Technologies (Lumen) Manhole Adjustments  
Alternative Bid 2: AT&T Manhole Adjustments

The adjustment of the facilities owned by Lumen and AT&T, are also included in the bid package as alternative bid schedules. If Lumen and AT&T approve the award of their respective alternative bid schedules, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by the utility owners through reimbursement letter Agreements that will be executed by the Director of Transportation.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid for the sum of all bid schedules.

**Environmental Findings**

The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities exemption because the Rainbow Canyon Road resurfacing does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt for the approximate 1 mile segment of Rainbow Canyon Road to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is anticipated to begin in early summer 2022. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$933,234. The County improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 Funds, Lumen and AT&T are responsible for funding their respective alternative bid schedules in full if approved.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

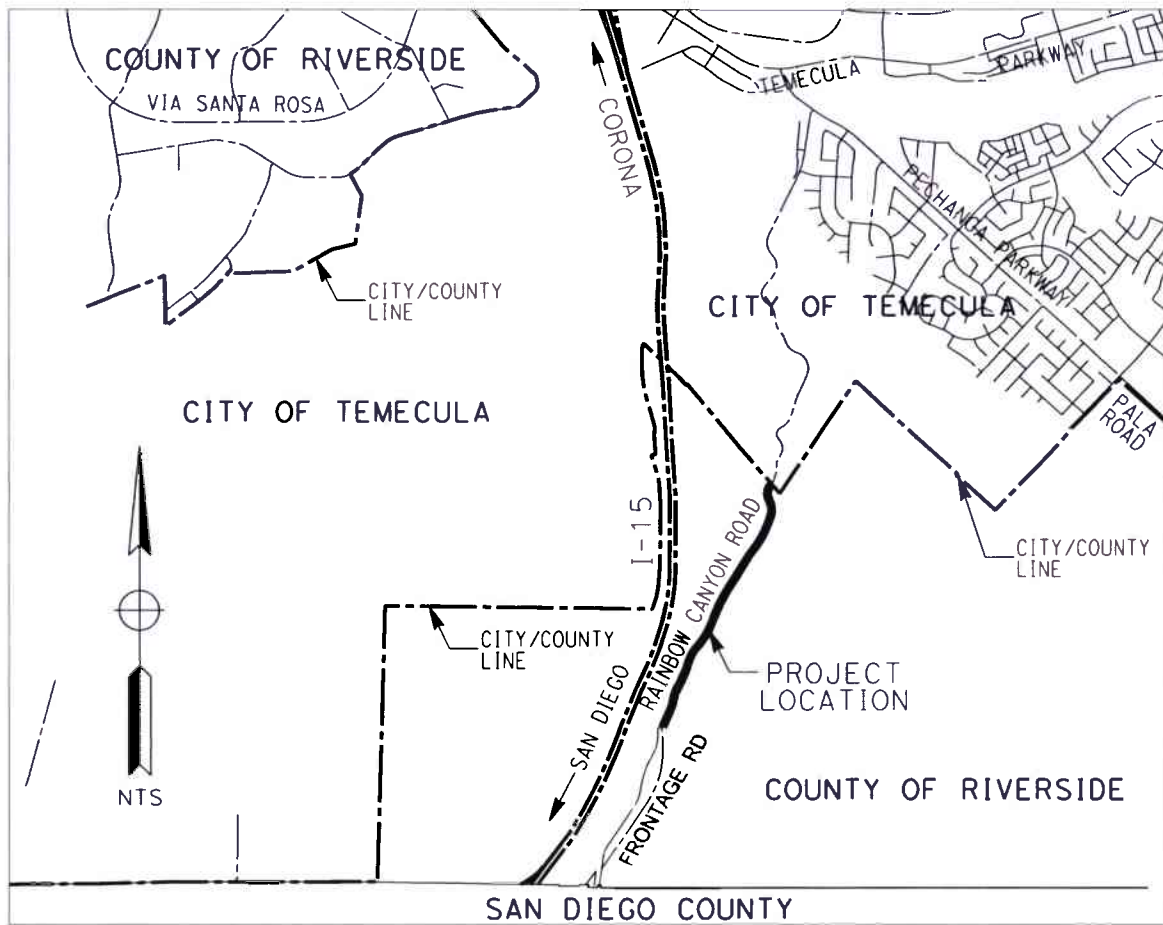
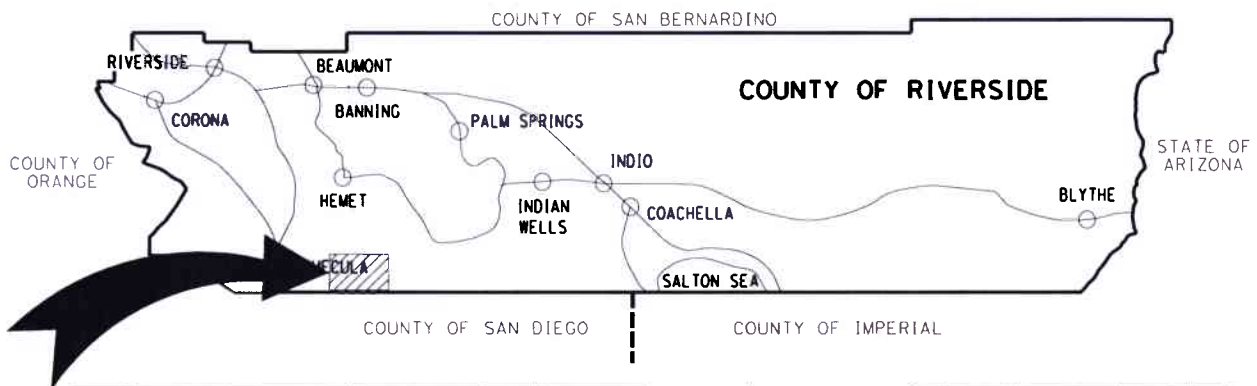

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface Rainbow Canyon Road from the northerly intersection of Rainbow Canyon Road and Frontage Road to the City of Temecula limits. Rainbow Canyon Road is classified as a Secondary highway in the County of Riverside's General Plan. Rainbow Canyon Road is currently 26 feet wide with an Asphalt Concrete (AC) dike and 3 low flow crossing areas along various segments of the roadway. The proposed project will include cold planing followed by overlaying back with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA.).

The proposed project will also include:

- Reconstruction of AC dike
- Construction of AC dike along road sections adjacent to slopes
- Placement of safety edge and shoulder backing
- Striping of roadway, including pavement markers and reflectors
- Salvage/removal and installation of new signs
- Reconstruct existing earthen swale
- Utility adjustments
- Reconstruct existing AC and concrete driveways

**ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:**

No additional right-of-way will be required to construct the proposed improvements. The project improvements will be within the existing footprint of the roadway.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County MSHCP. In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside of cell criteria area. This project is considered to be an operation and maintenance activity; therefore, it is a covered activity under the Western Riverside County MSHCP.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

**The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:**

**Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities** – The project proposes to resurface and construct associated improvements to approximately 5,174 feet of Rainbow Canyon Road from the northerly intersection of Rainbow Canyon Road and Frontage Road to the City of Temecula limits. The project in its entirety is consistent with Section 15301(c) because it does not create additional traffic lanes and involves no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

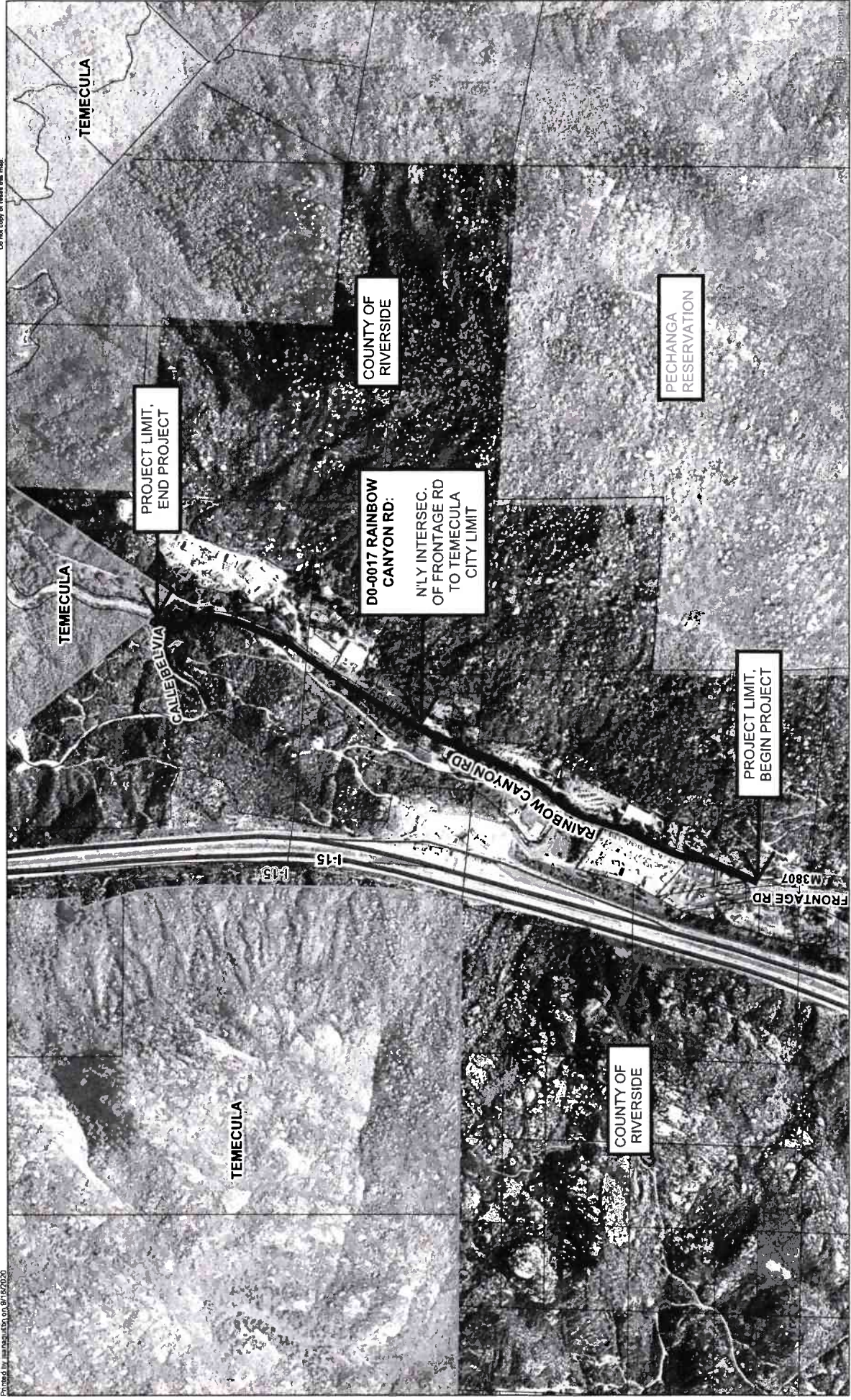


