RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorize allocation and use of 2nd District DA/DM Funds for Hidden Valley Wildlife Area entrance signage and the Nature Center interpretive signage for the Santa Ana Watershed viewpoint.
2. Direct the Executive Office to transfer up to \$4,060.16 from District 2 Developer Agreement Funds 30554 with \$3,903.02 and Public Facilities Fund 30567 with \$157.14, pursuant to billings received from the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District; and
3. Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the budget adjustments.



C.E.O. RECOMMENDATION:

BACKGROUND:

The Hidden Valley Wildlife Area is set on 1,500 scenic acres and has access to 25 miles of multi-use trails, a nature center, and several staging areas for equestrians and the Santa Ana River Trail (SART). Visitors can get away from the noise, lights of the city, and enjoy the beautiful views of the river or the bluff overlooking the wetland pond restoration project for migratory birds. Picnic areas and a self-guided Interpretive Trail await visitors along with various seasonal events and nature education outreach programs. The current entrance sign on Arlington Avenue was damaged beyond repair due to car accident and needs to be replaced to provide visitors with better facility identification. In addition, the Hidden Valley Nature Center offers self-guided tours with interpretive panels along the Santa Ana River Watershed viewpoint which have faded over the years and need to be updated and replaced.

These funds will go towards replacing the damaged entrance sign on Arlington Avenue as well as towards the interpretive signs around the Nature Center itself.

Additional Fiscal Info

RivCoParks is requesting the use of \$4,060.16 of District 2 Developer Agreement funds for Hidden Valley Wildlife Area entrance signage and the Nature Center interpretive signage for the Santa Ana Watershed viewpoint. The \$4,060.16 District 2 Developer Agreement Funds includes Habitat Conservation & Open-Space Fund 30554 with \$3,903.02 and Public Facilities Fund 30567 with \$157.14.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

These improvements will increase RivCoParks' interpretive presence with updated information about the current condition, projects, and importance of our Santa Ana River Watershed region. The new front entrance sign will allow visitors better facility identification.
