

**BACKGROUND:**

1. The donation to the Assistance League of Riverside will be used to support the organizations Wine & Roses event. The funds raised at this event will go towards expanding Operation School Bell which assist students that come from low-income households in obtaining clothing items needed for the school year within the Corona-Norco area.
2. The donation to the Riverside Downtown Partnership will be used to sponsor the upcoming 2022 Downtown Achievement Awards that will recognize outstanding individuals and organizations for their excellence in leadership and service to the downtown community.
3. The donation to the Jurupa Valley Citizens Patrol will be used to support the Jurupa Valley Station Volunteer program. Funds would be used to purchase GPS's and back-up cameras to assist the volunteers in safely driving to the scenes. In addition, the funds will be used to purchase road signs, barricades, lighting, extension cords and reflective safety vests that will assist the volunteers in all aspects of their services to the communities.
4. The donation to Destroy Duchenne will be used to support the Destroy Duchenne Awareness Project that supports ongoing community efforts in promoting attention and awareness around the seriousness of Duchenne muscular dystrophy.
