



BACKGROUND:

Riverside County Workforce Development Board (WDB) is a private sector led policy and oversight body that supports economic expansion and the development of the regional workforce. The WDB is governed by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) which mandates that 50% of the WDB's members must come from the business community. In addition, WDBs are required to have representation from universities or community colleges, economic development, and workforce representatives including labor organizations. This ensures that federal funds for workforce development activities are expended on training and career coaching that meets the needs of the business community. Pursuant to WIOA, the Riverside County Board of Supervisors, led by the Board Chairman who serves as the Chief Local Elected Official is responsible for appointing the WDB members for two-year terms.

Mr. Alfonso Jimenez, District Administrator for the Department of Rehabilitation, has over 15 years of experience in the human services and case management field along with ten years of management experience. Mr. Jimenez strives for independence and equality for persons with disabilities by advocating to address employment and training needs. At the Department of Rehabilitation, he has assisted with the development and delivery of programs for people with disabilities such as the Mental Health Cooperative, Students with Disabilities, and Transition Partnership Programs. He has assisted individuals with disabilities seeking employment, which resulted in success for both the job seekers and employers. Mr. Jimenez has been committed and involved with various groups, committees, and organizations including but not limited to Fresno's Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, the Interagency Council on Homeless for San Bernardino County, and the California Promise program, ensuring that diverse individuals with disabilities have a voice and are served. The Department of Rehabilitation collaborates with the WDB to increase disability awareness in the community. As District Administrator for the Inland Empire District within the California Department of Rehabilitation, Mr. Jimenez works in partnership with the WDB to provide services resulting in employment, independent living, and equality for individuals with disabilities.

Mr. Alfonso Jimenez has expressed interest in continuing to serve on the WDB as the Department of Rehabilitation representative for All Districts. If reappointed, he will serve a two-year term commencing March 21, 2022, and expiring March 21, 2024.
