



BACKGROUND:

Riverside County Workforce Development Board (WDB) is a private sector led policy and oversight body that supports economic expansion and the development of the regional workforce. The WDB is governed by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) which mandates that 50% of the WDB's members must come from the business community. In addition, WDBs are required to have representation from universities or community colleges, economic development, and workforce representatives including labor organizations. This ensures that federal funds for workforce development activities are expended on training and career coaching that meets the needs of the business community. Pursuant to WIOA, the Board of Supervisors, led by the Board Chairman who serves as the Chief Local Elected Official, is responsible for appointing the WDB members for two-year terms.

Nohora Vazquez has served as the adult education principal for the Lake Elsinore Unified School District for the past 15 years. She has contributed to developing a robust adult program that supports the educational and workforce goals of approximately 1,500 adults in the community. She started working for the Lake Elsinore Unified School District in 2003, where she

impacted numerous high school newcomers in need of bilingual and academic services. Mrs. Vazquez discovered her passion for the field of education and pursued first a teaching credential and then an administrative credential and a master's degree in educational leadership. She started as a Spanish teacher and focused her career on developing her leadership skills to support the education of immigrant families and those with low literacy levels in the Lake Elsinore community. Mrs. Vazquez is an expert in serving adults participating in Title II WIOA programs such as Adult Secondary Education, English as a Second Language, and Short-Term Career Technical Education.

Mrs. Vazquez is an official member of the Southwest Riverside Adult Ed. Consortium. She has collaborated to develop and implement the regional consortium plans and facilitated training and leadership activities for the ten participating consortium members. She served as the consortium's chair for the last three years, and in January 2022, she was voted as the new Co-director of the consortium. Mrs. Vazquez has a growing passion for creating equitable opportunities and braiding resources with our regional partners to equip all adult learners with the 21st century skills they need to contribute to our region's economy.

Ms. Nohora Vazquez has expressed interest in serving on the WDB as an Adult Education Representative for all Districts. If appointed, she will serve a two-year term commencing April 5, 2022, and expiring April 5, 2024.
