- 3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 4, 2022 at which time bids will be opened; and
- 4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface approximately 1.2 miles of Soboba Street from Stetson Avenue to Florida Avenue (State Highway 74) in the Community of East Hemet of Riverside County.

Soboba Street is classified a secondary highway in the County of Riverside's General Plan. Soboba Street is a two-lane road that travels in the north-south directions, and its width varies between 26-feet to 51-feet.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. Mainly, the proposed Soboba Street Resurfacing Project will consist of two treatment types. The first treatment consists of removing the existing asphalt concrete pavement and underlying material and placing back new Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement and Rubberized Hot Mix Asphalt (RHMA). The second treatment consist of grinding down a portion of the existing asphalt concrete pavement followed by overlaying back with RHMA.

Additional improvements include placement of AC dike, reconstruction of asphalt concrete driveways, construction of concrete curb and gutter, cross gutters, construction of Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant concrete access ramps, placement of safety edge to protect the outside edge of pavement, placing of traffic striping, pavement markings, regrading and widening of an existing drainage ditch of approximately 500-feet long located on the west side of Soboba Street just south of Florida Avenue, and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB-1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Soboba Street Resurfacing Project is one of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB-1 funds.

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Without SB-1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

Base Bid Schedule: Soboba Street Resurfacing and associated improvements

Alternative Bid 1:

Southern California Edison (SCE) Manhole Adjustments

Alternative Bid 2:

Frontier Manhole Adjustments

The adjustment of the facilities owned by SCE and Frontier, are also included in the bid package as alternative bid schedules. If SCE and Frontier approve the award of their respective alternative bid schedules, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by the utility owners through reimbursement letter Agreements that will be executed by the Director of Transportation.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid for the sum of all bid schedules.

Environmental Findings

The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities exemption because the Soboba Street resurfacing does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt for the approximate 1.2 miles segment of Soboba Street to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is anticipated to begin in early summer 2022. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,371,000. The County improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 Funds. SCE and Frontier are responsible for funding their respective alternative bid schedules in full if approved.

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There are no General Funds used in this project.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface approximately 1.21 miles of Soboba Street from Stetson Avenue to Florida Avenue (SR-74). Soboba Street, classified as a Major Highway in the County of Riverside General Plan, is a two-lane road varying between 26 feet to 51 feet in width. The proposed project will include:

- Removing existing asphalt overlaying with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA)
- Pedestrian ramp upgrades to meet current ADA standards
- Reconstruction of existing concrete and asphalt driveways, asphalt concrete berm/dike, cross gutter and spandrels, and curb and gutter
- Regrading and widening a drainage ditch on the west side of Soboba Street at Florida Avenue (Approx. 500 feet)
- Utility adjustments
- Vegetation and sediment removal
- Striping of roadway

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed improvements will be constructed within existing County right-of-way. Temporary construction easements may be required.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). The project area is outside of criteria cells. In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity within and outside of criteria cells. The project is an operation and maintenance project and therefore is a covered activity.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1st - September 1st), a preconstruction nesting bird survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).


