Summary

The State Legislature enacted the County Service Area Law to provide broad statutory authority for County Boards of Supervisors to use County Service Areas ("CSA") as a method to finance and provide needed public facilities and services within unincorporated areas of the county. Every fiscal year, in conjunction with the Board's consideration of the budget for the County of Riverside, the Board of Supervisors determines the nature, extent and cost of the services to be provided in each CSA which is submitted to the Board in a report prepared by the Office of Economic Development.

Pursuant to Riverside County Ordinance No. 573 and Government Code 25215 et seq., the proposed fiscal year 2022-2023 charges are attached as Exhibit A. County Service Areas provide municipal services to residential neighborhoods such as landscape maintenance, street lighting, street sweeping and road maintenance; the services that each community receives are determined during the planning phase of new development. The cost associated with providing enhanced services are unique to each community. Applicable residential development is required to prepare an engineer's report that includes an annual adjustment by the greater of two percent, or the cumulative percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers (CPI-U). The annual adjustment proposed for fiscal year 2022-2023 is based on the CPI-U as of March 2022. As required by Section 3 of County Ordinance No. 573, a public hearing to hear and consider testimony regarding the fiscal year 2022-2023 charges detailed in Exhibit A is proposed to be set for June 21, 2022.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

County Service Areas allow communities in unincorporated areas to pay for and receive specific municipal services. These services are unique to each community and enhance the quality of life.
