4. Direct the Department of Waste Resources (Department) to post the Notice of Exemption (NOE) upon approval of the Project.

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

In addition to establishing fees and penalties, Ordinance No. 779 includes the basis for operating regulations that include waste inspection, salvaging and safety. In order to verify that the current refuse rates are appropriate to offset expenses, the Department prudently reviews its operations annually and forecasts capital improvements, expansion projects, and future expenses and liabilities with a projection of 20 years. Since revenue from in-county tonnage delivered to the landfills represents the majority of the Enterprise Fund's total revenue, it is important to accurately project future tonnage growth or decline. Because of stricter regulatory compliance requirements to increase landfill diversion to 75%, we anticipate zero tonnage growth in coming years.

For these reasons, and in consideration of inflation factors including salary increases, stricter regulatory compliance requirements and increased permitting fees, the Department proposes to increase landfill disposal fees by the percentage change in Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario index for the 12-month period ending January 2022, which is calculated to be 8.59%, **Attachment A – Ordinance No. 779.23**. Contracted disposal rates as negotiated pursuant to various long-term, transfer station Waste Delivery Agreements shall be adjusted per terms previously approved by the Board of Supervisors. **Attachment B – Contracted Rates.**

In the last five years, the number of vehicles attributed to residential customers at landfills has increased by 93%, with counts increase from 143,000 vehicles per year to 277,000 vehicles per year. As a result of this increase in traffic, queues at landfills can exceed over an hour in wait time. In an effort to improve efficiency, reduce transaction processing time, and improve customer service, the Department proposes to establish flat rate fees for three different vehicle types as allowed by the California Code of Regulations (14 CCR §18815.9 (g)(3)(A)). The flat rate charge will significantly reduce the need to weigh empty residential vehicles exiting the landfill, thereby reducing congestion at the scale house while freeing up one inbound/outbound scale for mostly in-bound traffic. Although regulations allow for the implementation of a flat rate without analysis, the Department conducted a study during the month of December 2021 to assess the average weight of vehicle types proposed for flat rating. For one hour each day, all proposed vehicle types were weighed full and empty at each landfill location so that the

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Department could obtain the disposal load weight by vehicle type. The study hour varied daily and the proposed rates are based on the average load weight as determined by the study, **Attachment C – Flat Rate Study**. While not projecting tonnage growth, traffic volumes are anticipated to continue increasing as residential customers take advantage of the County's low disposal rates and home development continues to encroach closer to landfills. The Department's proposed drive-up rates (per ton rate and flat rate fees), are lower in comparison to neighboring counties, **Attachment D – Rate Comparison**.

The Department proposes to increase tire fees from \$2.00/tire to \$4.00 tire due to an increase in handling/processing costs. The Department's cost for tire handling/processing increased from \$50,000 in FY 19/20 to \$68,000 in FY 20/21, raising the subsidy from 64% to 75% respectively. Although the proposed increase reduces the subsidy to 50%, it is anticipated that this subsidy will continue to curb/prevent illegal dumping.

The Department continues to pilot the operation of a Materials Reuse Store at the Lamb Canyon Landfill. The program will divert recyclable waste streams for reuse. Until full program costs are defined, the Department proposes to charge fees consistent with the value of these commodities. Proposed rates are based on commodity pricing received by the Department in CY2021, plus a \$6.25 per item surcharge for staff time involved in sorting, inspecting and storing material for sale. The Department will continue to pilot the operation of a Materials Reuse program to identify additional program costs.

**CEQA Findings**

The Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) (General Rule for Exemption), as it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that this Project would have a direct, indirect, or cumulatively significant effect on the environment; therefore, the activity is exempt under CEQA. Furthermore, pursuant to State CEQA

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Guidelines, Section 15273 (Rates, Tolls, Fares, and Charges), the Project is found to be statutorily exempt from CEQA, because the proposed changes are for the purpose of:

- Meeting operating expense, including employee wage rates and fringe benefits;
- Purchasing or leasing supplies, equipment, or materials;
- Meeting financial reserve needs and requirements; and
- Obtaining funds for existing capital projects, necessary to maintain service within existing service areas.

A NOE to this effect will be posted with the County Clerk upon adoption of Ordinance 779.23.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

Waste Disposal Fees are reviewed annually, and are subject to CPI adjustment which, for this period, is 8.59%. Fee increases are needed in order to offset impacts due to inflationary factors while meeting the need for capital improvements, expansion projects at County landfills, equipment purchases, increasing program expenses which allow for the continued protection of the general public health and welfare by efficient management of Riverside County's solid waste system. The Waste Disposal Fees charged under Ordinance 779.23 continue to be the lowest in the Southern California region, and the Department does not anticipate an increase in illegal dumping as a result of these fee increases.



Effective July 1, 2022**

The Residential Self-Haul Card shall be necessary for admittance to the Oasis Landfill for all residential haulers. For use by residents of Oasis, Mecca, North Shore, and Thermal.

**RESIDENTIAL CARD REGULATIONS:**

**Authority:** Riverside County Ordinance No. 745 requires that, "Every tenant, occupier, operator, or owner of a residence...not less than once a week all Solid Waste created, produced or brought upon the property shall be moved to an approved disposal facility."

1. **Number of Uses** - Monthly Residential Self-Haul Card allows up to 4-400 lb. standard load uses per month.
2. **Expiration Date** - The expiration date for the yearly card is the last day of the fiscal year, June 30th. The expiration date for monthly cards is the last day of the month. In addition, any unused punches for each month will expire on the last day of that month.
3. **No Refunds** - There will be no refunds on partially used cards.
4. **Standard Load** - The maximum load allowed access to the landfill with one use of the Residential Self-Haul Card will be four hundred (400) pounds, which is equivalent to one punch on the card. If the Gate Services Assistant judges a load to be over this Standard Load limit, two or more punches will be made to the card.
5. **Cost** - The Residential Self-Haul Card discounted rate is seventeen dollars and sixty nine cents (\$17.69) per month.
6. **Payment Options – Cards may be purchased:**

7. **Lost Cards** - Lost cards are to be reported immediately. The customer will not be responsible for unauthorized use of a card after if it is reported lost to the Waste Resources business office located at 14310 Frederick Street, Moreno Valley, CA 92553, (951) 486-3200.
8. **Uncovered Load Fee** - A fee of \$10 will be assessed per unsecured load of refuse which has exposed material which in the opinion of the General Manager-Chief Engineer or his/her designee may litter roadways to the landfill or along landfill roads to the dumping pad.
9. **Passenger/Light Duty Tires** - Limited to 5 (five) Tires Per Residential Customer Per Day. No semi tires. \$4.00/fee per tire.

- 11. Alternative Riverside County Landfill Usage** – In the event that the rural landfill is unable to accept waste on a normal operating day, customers will be directed to a scaled Riverside County landfill and may use their Residential Self Haul Card.

RURAL SITE ACCESS - COMMERCIAL CARDS - OASIS LANDFILL  
FOR  
RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF WASTE RESOURCES  
Effective July 1, 2022**

The Rural Site Access Commercial Card shall be necessary for admittance to the Oasis Landfill for all non-permitted/contracted entities hauling commercial waste. For use by commercial entities of Oasis, Mecca, North Shore, and Thermal.

**COMMERCIAL CARD REGULATIONS:**

A Rural Site Access Commercial Card provides for disposal of commercial waste generated within the remote service areas and is required unless a permitted waste hauler or other large commercial users have negotiated a separate contract for disposal access to rural landfills with the County.

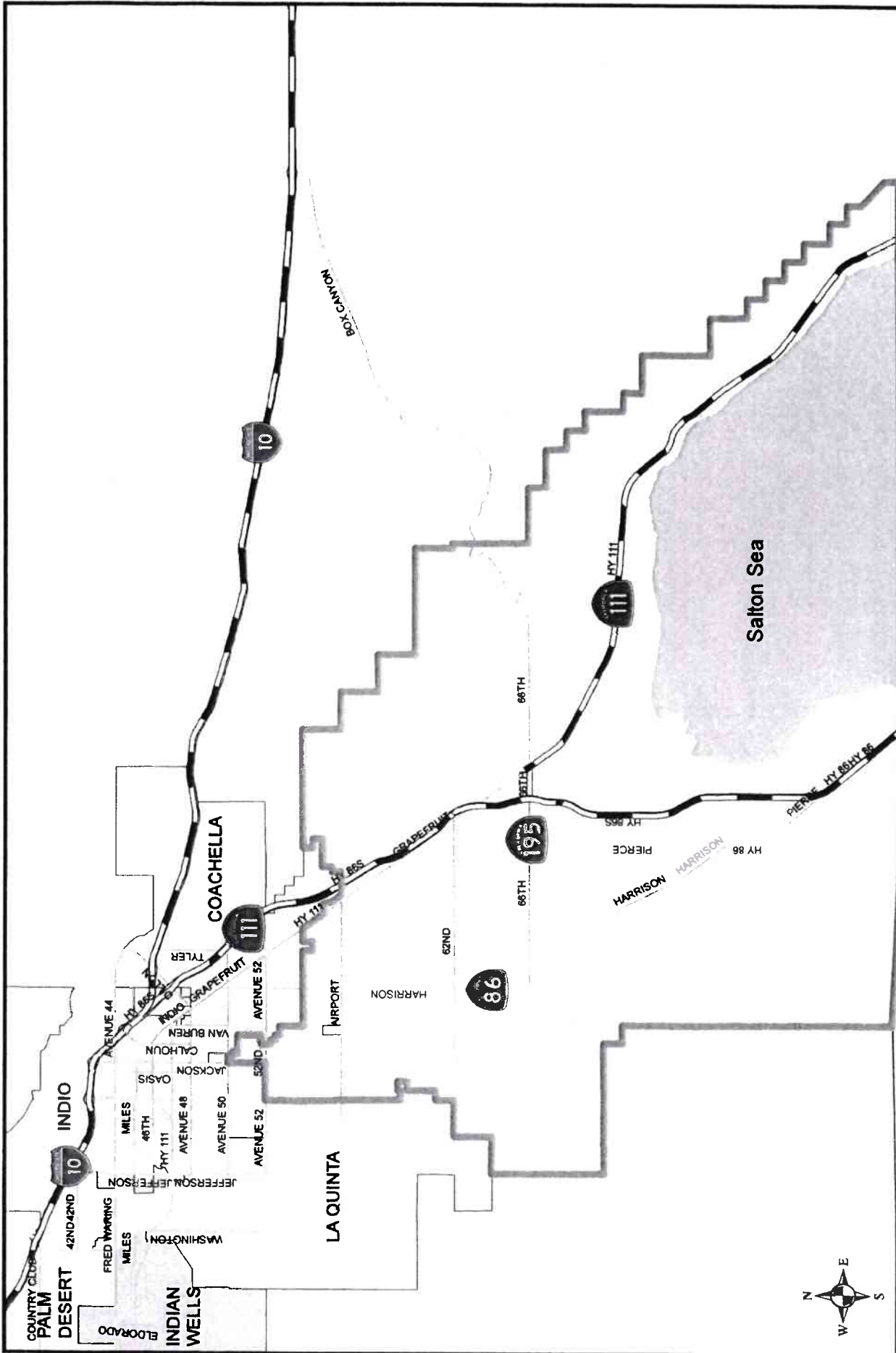
1. **Number of Uses** - The Commercial Card will have twenty-four (24) ½ ton available uses.
2. **Expiration Date** - There is no expiration date for the Commercial Card.
3. **No Refunds** - If a commercial operator goes out of business, there shall be no refund for the unused card punches.
4. **Cost** - The Commercial Card will be priced at five hundred fifty-six dollars and twelve cents (\$556.12).
5. **Payment for Card** - The card shall be purchased in advance of usage. Cards may be purchased at any time of the year. Acceptable forms of payment at the fee booth include money order or cashier's check. Cash, personal/business checks, and credit/debit card payments are accepted at the Department's business office or by phone (951) 486-3200.
6. **Lost Cards** - Lost cards are to be reported immediately. The customer will not be responsible for unauthorized use of a card after it is reported lost to the Waste Resources business office located at 14310 Frederick St., Moreno Valley, CA. (951) 486-3200.
7. **Uncovered Load Fee** - A fee of \$10.00 will be assessed per uncovered load of refuse which has exposed material which in the opinion of the General Manager-Chief Engineer or his/her designee may litter roadways to the landfill or along landfill roads to the dumping pad.
8. **Restrictions on Use of Card** - Hazardous waste, tires, or other hard-to-handle waste will not be accepted at the Oasis landfill from commercial haulers.
9. **Alternative Riverside County Landfill Usage** - In the event that the rural landfill is unable to accept waste on a normal operating day, customers will be directed to a scaled Riverside County landfill and may use their Rural Site Commercial Card.

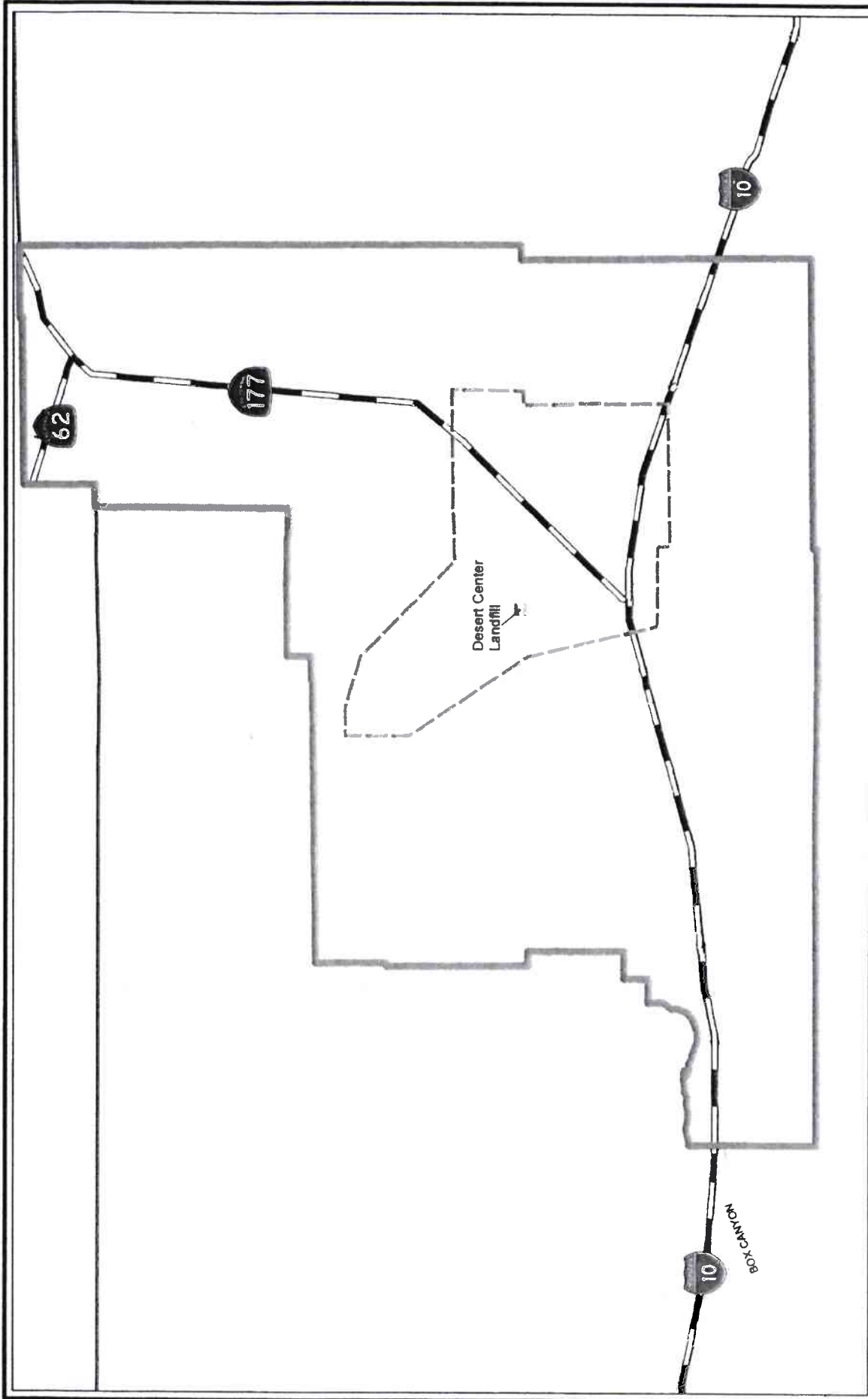

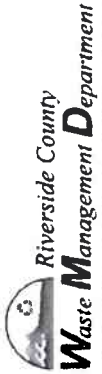
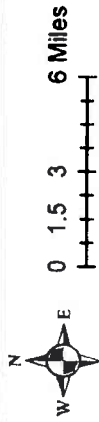

The project is exempt from the provisions of CEQA, specifically by the State CEQA Guidelines as identified below. The project will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of categorical exemptions as detailed under State CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2. The project will not cause any impacts to scenic resources, historic resources, or unique sensitive environments. Further, no unusual circumstances or potential cumulative impacts would occur that may reasonably create a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical environmental impact.

**REASONS FOR EXEMPTION:**

**Section 15061(b)(3) - General Rule Exemption**

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects, which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA.

**This project is exempt under Section 15061(b)(3) because:**

The Project proposes to increase landfill disposal fees/rates consistent with the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for certain solid waste streams. Direct haul/non-contracted rate for routine refuse, for example, is proposed to increase from the current \$42.68 per ton to \$46.35 per ton, an 8.59% increase. Additionally, the Project also proposes to increase tire fees from \$2.00/tire to \$4.00/tire due to an increase in handling/processing costs. Various other fee structure changes are also proposed, including hard to handle waste among others (see Attachment A).

The Project would merely increase waste disposal fees/rates to be consistent with the CPI for the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario index for the 12 month period ending January 2022, propose to establish flat rate fees for three different vehicle types and implement other fee structural changes. Changes in the fee structure would not have an effect on environmental resources.

Based upon the entire record, the Project would not result in the potential for any significant effect on the environment. This determination is an issue of fact and sufficient evidence exists in the record that the activity will not have a significant effect on the environment. As such, the exemption applies and no further evaluation under CEQA is required. See *Muzzy Ranch Co. v. Solano County Airport Land Use Comm'n* (2007) 41 Cal. 4<sup>th</sup> 372.

**Section 15273. Rates, Tolls, Fares, and Charges**

CEQA does not apply to the establishment, modification, structuring, restructuring, or approval of rates, tolls, fares, and other charges by public agencies which the public agency finds are for the purpose of:

- Meeting operating expenses, including employee wage rates and fringe benefits,
- Purchasing or leasing supplies, equipment, or materials,
- Meeting financial reserve needs and requirements,
- Obtaining funds for capital projects, necessary to maintain service within existing service areas, or
- Obtaining funds necessary to maintain such intra-city transfers as are authorized by city charter.

**This project is exempt under Section 15273 because:**

The Project involves the modification and restructuring of fees and approval of rates for the purpose of meeting operating expenses, and other inflation factors including salary increases, stricter regulatory compliance requirements and increased permitting fees. As such, due to the administrative nature of the Project, no environmental resources will be affected; therefore, the Project meets the scope and intent of Section 15273, Statutory Exemption.

**FINDINGS:**

1. Based upon the identified exemptions and justifications above, the RCDWR, on behalf of the County, hereby concludes that no physical environmental impacts are anticipated to occur and the Project as proposed is exempt under CEQA. No further environmental analysis is warranted.
2. The proposed Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3), and statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15273.

The Residential Self-Haul Card shall be necessary for admittance to the Oasis Landfill for all residential haulers. For use by residents of Oasis, Mecca, North Shore and Thermal.

**RESIDENTIAL CARD REGULATIONS:**

**Authority:** Riverside County Ordinance No. 745 requires that: Every tenant, occupier, operator or owner of a residence... not less than once a week, all Solid Waste material produced or brought upon the property shall be moved to an approved disposal facility.

- Number of Uses** - Monthly Residential Self-Haul Card allows up to 4-400 lb. standard load uses per month.
- Expiration Date** - The expiration date for the yearly card is the last day of the fiscal year, June 30th. The expiration date for monthly cards is the last day of the month. In addition, any unused punches for each month will expire on the last day of that month.
- No Refunds** - There will be no refunds on partially used cards.
- Standard Load** - The maximum load allowed access to the landfill with one use of the Residential Self-Haul Card will be four hundred (400) pounds, which is equivalent to one punch on the card. If the Gate Services Assistant judges a load to be over the Standard Load limit two or more punches will be made to the card.
- Cost** - The Residential Self-Haul Card discounted rate is seventeen dollars and sixty-nine cents (\$17.69) per month.

- Passenger/Light Duty Tires** - Limited to 5 (five) Tires Per Residential Customer Per Day. No semi-trails \$4.00/tee per tire.

The Rural Site Access Commercial Card shall be necessary for admittance to the Oasis Landfill for all non-residential haulers, but excludes hauling commercial waste. For use by commercial entities of Oasis, Mecca, North Shore, and Thermal.

**COMMERCIAL CARD REGULATIONS**

A Rural Site Access Commercial Card provides for disposal of commercial waste generated within the unincorporated areas and is required unless a permitted waste hauler or other large commercial entity has negotiated a separate contract for disposal access to rural landfills with the County.

- Number of Uses** - The Commercial Card will have twenty four (24) 10-ton available uses.
- Expiration Date** - There is no expiration date for the Commercial Card.
- No Refunds** - If a commercial operator goes out of business, there shall be no refund for the unused card punches.
- Cost** - The Commercial Card will be priced at five hundred fifty-six dollars and twelve cents (\$556.12).
- Payment for Card** - The card shall be purchased in advance of usage. Cards may be purchased at any time of the year. Acceptable forms of payment at the fee booth include money order or cashier's check. Cash, personal/business checks, and credit/debit card payments are accepted at the Department's business office or by phone (951) 486-3200.
- Lost Cards** - Lost cards are to be reported immediately. The customer will not be responsible for unauthorized use of a card after it is reported lost by the Waste Resources business office located at 14310 Frederick St. Moreno Valley, CA (951) 486-3200.
- Uncovered Load Fee** - A fee of \$10.00 will be assessed per uncovered load of refuse which has exposed material which in the opinion of the General Manager, Chief Engineer or his/her designee may alter (overlays) the landfill or along landfill roads to the dumping pad.
- Restrictions on Use of Card** - Hazardous waste, farm or other hard to handle waste will not be accepted at the Oasis landfill from commercial haulers.
- Alternative Riverside County Landfill Usage** - In the event that the rural landfill is unable to accept waste on a normal operating day, customers will be directed to a selected Riverside County landfill and may use their Rural Site Commercial Card.

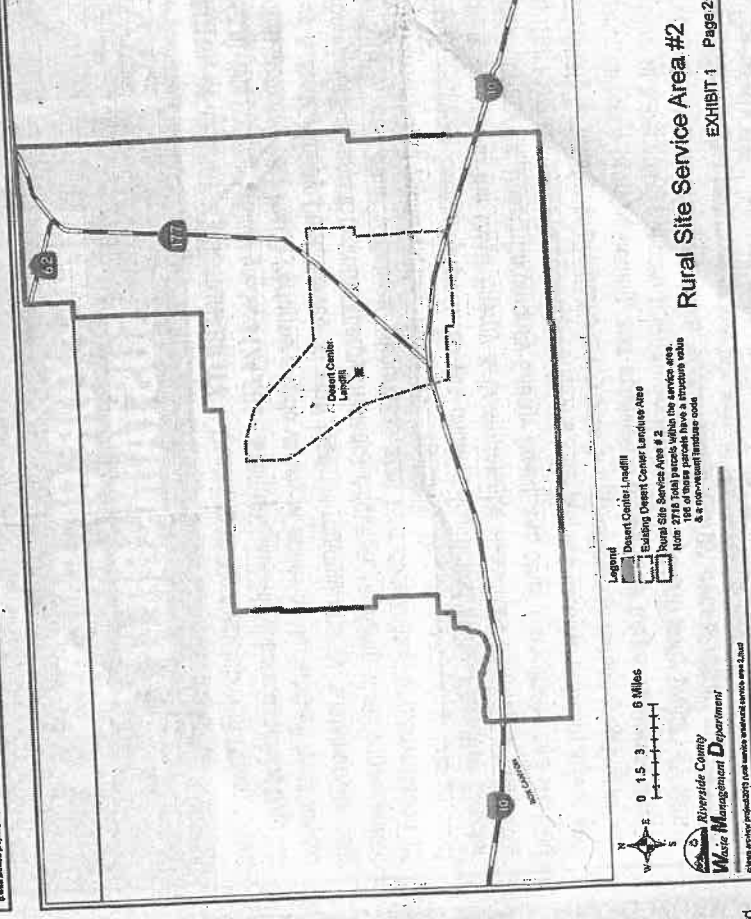
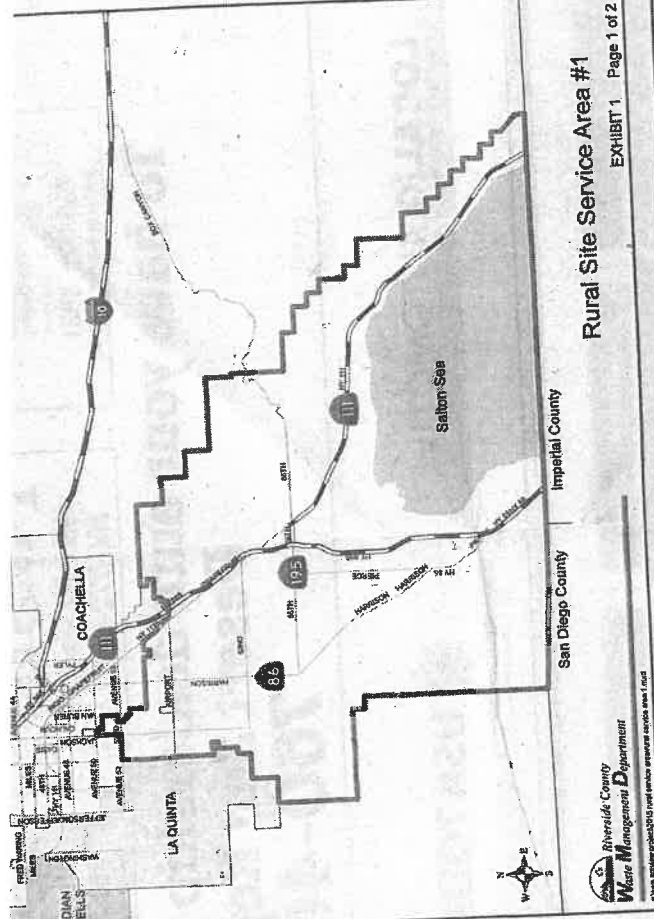

APPENDIX C TO ORDINANCE NO. 779.23 RURAL SITE ACCESS - COMMERCIAL CARDS - OASIS LANDFILL FOR RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF WASTE RESOURCES Effective July 1, 2022

The Rural Site Access Commercial Card shall be necessary for admittance to the Oasis Landfill for all nonpermitted/contracted entities hauling commercial waste. For use by commercial entities of Oasis, Mecca, North Shore, and Thermal.

COMMERCIAL CARD REGULATIONS:

A Rural Site Access Commercial Card provides for disposal of commercial waste generated within the remote service areas and is required unless a permitted waste hauler or other large commercial users have negotiated a separate contract for disposal access to rural landfills with the County.

- Number of Uses - The Commercial Card will have twenty-four (24) 1/2 ton available uses.
- Expiration Date - There is no expiration date for the Commercial Card.
- No Refunds - If a commercial operator goes out of business, there shall be no refund for the unused card punches.
- Cost - The Commercial Card will be priced at five hundred fifty-six dollars and twelve cents (\$556.12).
- Payment for Card - The card shall be purchased in advance of usage. Cards may be purchased at any time of the year. Acceptable forms of payment at the fee booth include money order or cashier's check. Cash, personal/business checks, and credit/debit card payments are accepted at the Department's business office or by phone (951) 486-3200.
- Lost Cards - Lost cards are to be reported immediately. The customer will not be responsible for unauthorized use of a card after it is reported lost to the Waste Resources business office located at 14310 Frederick St., Moreno Valley, CA. (951) 486-3200.
- Uncovered Load Fee - A fee of \$10.00 will be assessed per uncovered load of refuse which has exposed material which in the opinion of the General Manager/Chief Engineer or his/her designee may litter roadways to the landfill or along landfill roads to the dumping pad.
- Restrictions on Use of Card - Hazardous waste, tires, or other hard-to-handle waste will not be accepted at the Oasis landfill from commercial haulers.
- Alternative Riverside County Landfill Usage - In the event that the rural landfill is unable to accept waste on a normal operating day, customers will be directed to a scaled Riverside County landfill and may use their Rural Site Commercial Card.
