BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Indian Wells City Council approved the First Amendment to the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services. The City of Indian Wells has requested a modification to their level of service of twelve (12) additional patrol hours per day. The Department has requested two new Deputy Sheriff – 84 PCNs to accommodate this request.

The total cost of this Amendment is estimated at \$22,000 for FY21/22. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This is an Amendment to the Law Enforcement Service Agreement with the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services, which the City of Indian Wells approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates.
