2. Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the budget adjustments shown on Schedule A.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County is currently constructing curb, gutter, and sidewalk improvements along the north side of Oleander Avenue between Mead Valley Elementary School and Haines Street, extending the existing sidewalk improvements easterly to Haines Street. The total length of the project is approximately 500 feet and includes pavement widening along the north side of Oleander Avenue. These improvements will enhance pedestrian and bicycle safety and provide an improved safe route to school.

A future second phase of the project (Oleander Avenue Sidewalk Safety Improvements Phase 2) is proposed between Haines St and Clark St. This future project will also construct curb, gutter, and sidewalk improvements along the north side of Oleander Ave, extending the safe routes to school sidewalk network easterly.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The curb, gutter, and sidewalk improvements will enhance pedestrian and bicycle safety and provide an improved safe route to school.

Additional Fiscal Information

On April 28, 2015, the Mead Valley Revitalization Fund was established to improve infrastructure and augment public services in the Mead Valley community immediately surrounding the I-215 commercial/industrial zone.
