

BACKGROUND:

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Rancho Damacitas - \$1,000 funds will support the Empowerment Village which helps struggling single mothers with young children obtain stability.
2. Idyllwild Community Center – \$1,375 funds will assist with repairs to the community pickleball court fence.
3. Ramona Bowl Amphitheatre - \$2,500 will help with costs to repair damages at the Ramona Bowl caused by a leak in the roof.

4. Southwest Riverside County Inland Empire Organization - \$250 will benefit the Inaugural Juneteenth Awards Banquet recognizing individuals who display exceptional leadership throughout our community.
5. Idyllwild Help Center - \$3,500 funds will help low-income residents with gas vouchers to travel to medical appointments down the hill.
6. Mountain Communities Fire Safe Council - \$4,000 will assist with the removal of dead, dying, or diseased trees to provide defensible space for low-income, elderly, and/or disabled property owners.
7. Art Alliance of Idyllwild - \$1,000 funding will support the free shuttle service for the 24th Annual Art Alliance of Idyllwild event.
8. Professional Women's Roundtable - \$1,500 will go toward scholarships for local graduating high school seniors or women going back to college.
9. Hospice of the Valleys - \$2,500 will assist with the Hospice of the Valley's senior assistance program.
10. Temecula Valley Chamber of Commerce - \$1,200 the funds will be utilized for the Temecula State of the City Address. This event allows communication directly to the citizens as to current and future initiatives within the city.
11. Hemet San Jacinto Valley Chamber of Commerce - \$1,000 the funding will be used for the annual awards presentation that honors and supports exceptional individuals that demonstrate strong community involvement in the Hemet/San Jacinto area.
12. Law Enforcement Appreciation Committee - \$1,000 funds will help support the Law Enforcement Appreciation Dinner recognizing the men and women who protect our safety each day.
13. Riverside County Sheriff's Department - \$1,000 funds will support the Sheriff's Annual Awards Ceremony honoring and recognizing the men and women who protect our safety each day.
14. Living Free - \$10,000 funds will support War Horse Creek which helps veterans transition from the military to civilian life.
