

BACKGROUND:

Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Girl Scouts of San Gorgonio Council - \$13,000 funding will provide youth the opportunity to participate in the summer horse camp and will provide campership care packages. To ensure equity for all girls attending, the campership care packages will be given to children whose families cannot afford a sleeping bag, flashlight, refillable water bottle, camp t-shirt, and toiletries.

2. Habitat for Humanity Inland Valley - \$57,000 will be used toward the Urgent Repair Program which assists with a variety of dwelling repairs including water heater replacement, leaky roof repair, and/or health and safety-related repairs.
