

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to three (3) 2022 High School graduates, who served on the Fifth District Youth Advisory Council, and are recipients of the Fifth District Youth Advisory Council (YAC) Scholarship:

1. This scholarship was designed to reward Fifth District YAC members' hard work during their council year(s), assist in the pursuit of their education and improve our community.
 - a. All YAC members graduating from the 12th grade were eligible to apply for this scholarship.

2. Eligibility considerations are as follows:
 - a. Must be a graduating senior attending a community college, public/private college or university, or eligible trade school.
 - b. Total number of hours that were contributed to the council.
 - c. Total number of years that the student has served on the Fifth District YAC. (Up to \$250 per year served)
 - d. YAC members must provide an essay that demonstrates what YAC means for them, growth while being a part of the council, and ideas or projects that they have contributed to the council.
 - e. Must provide acceptance letter and provisional transcript.
