BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Riverside County Sheriff's Department donation will be used to support their annual awards ceremony that recognizes sworn and non-sworn staff, members of the community and volunteers for their outstanding efforts and services within the communities of Riverside County.
2. Community Center for Health Minds (CCHM) funding will be used to support operations, educational enrichment and rehabilitation programs/services which will assist and encourage healthy behaviors.
3. Moreno Valley Chamber of Commerce donation will support their programs, services and community events that benefit the constituents and small businesses of Moreno Valley.
4. The American Outreach Foundation donation will support the Donate Your Powerchair program, which provides veterans, seniors and low-income families with mobility devices-electric wheelchair or scooters within the Fifth district communities. Funds will also be used towards the cost assistance for pickup/delivery powerchairs, refurbishing materials, batteries, and other miscellaneous program costs like maintenance calls and repairs.

5. Habitat for Humanity San Gorgonio Pass Area funds will provide support for affordable housing as well as beautification projects in the pass area. Through their "A Brush with Kindness" program, various volunteers aim to improve the quality of life for low-income families. This program provides services such as painting, landscaping and clean-up of entire blocks.
6. Hemet San Jacinto Valley Chamber of Commerce donation will support their small businesses community events such as their Chamber Installation Awards event.
7. Law Enforcement Appreciation Committee donation will be used to support their annual Law Enforcement Appreciation & Recognition ceremony that honors collaboration efforts between various law enforcement agencies and the community.
8. Menifee Valley Chamber of Commerce donation will support their business and citizen programs, services, and community events which will assist with small businesses economic growth in the area. By providing resources and information to business owners and marketing assistance as well as helping local businesses connect with job seekers.
