3. Approve the project proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A".



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated March 22, 2022 (Agenda Item 3.35), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Rainbow Canyon Road Resurfacing Project from Frontage Road to the City of Temecula boundary line in the Community of Rainbow of Riverside County.

Rainbow Canyon Road is classified a secondary highway in the County of Riverside's General Plan. Rainbow Canyon Road is currently 26 feet wide with two lanes that travel in the north-south directions.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. Mainly, the proposed Rainbow Canyon Road Resurfacing Project will consist of two treatment types. The first treatment consists of grinding down a portion of the pavement followed by overlaying back with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) on an approximately 0.4 miles segment of roadway. The second treatment will clean, crack seal, and tack coat an approximately 0.6 mile segment of roadway prior to overlaying the existing asphalt with HMA.

Additional improvements include placement of AC dike, reconstruction of asphalt concrete driveways, concrete driveways, placement of safety edge and shoulder backing to protect the outside edge of pavement, placing of traffic striping, pavement markings, replacing existing guardrail, and other associated work.

The Contract includes following bid schedules of work:

- Base Bid Schedule: Rainbow Canyon Road Resurfacing
- Alternative Bid Schedule 1: Lumen Technologies Manhole Adjustments
- Alternative Bid Schedule 2: Not Selected for Award (AT&T Manhole Adjustments)

Lumen Technologies has accepted the bid prices proposed by ATP General Engineering for alternative bid schedule 1, and the cost for the work will be reimbursed by Lumen Technologies

through a reimbursement Agreement. The Director of Transportation has the authority to sign reimbursement Agreements up to \$100,000 per Minute Order dated November 19, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.25).

AT&T has rejected the bid prices proposed by ATP General Engineering for alternative bid schedule 2.

The contractor, ATP General Engineering, is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt for the approximate 1 mile segment of Rainbow Canyon Road to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is anticipated to begin in early summer 2022. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in Fiscal Year 2022/2023 and will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 and Lumen Technologies funds.

The proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A" includes Contract award amount and other associated costs.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

A total of four bids were received on Wednesday April 13, 2022 ranging from \$988,988 to \$1,150,232. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by ATP General Engineering, in the amount of \$988,988 which is \$55,754 (6%) above the Engineer's Estimate. The contract amount (\$987,988) varies from bid amount (\$988,988) because Alternative Bid Schedule 2 in the amount of \$1,000 is not selected for award.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to ATP General Engineering in the amount of \$987,988.

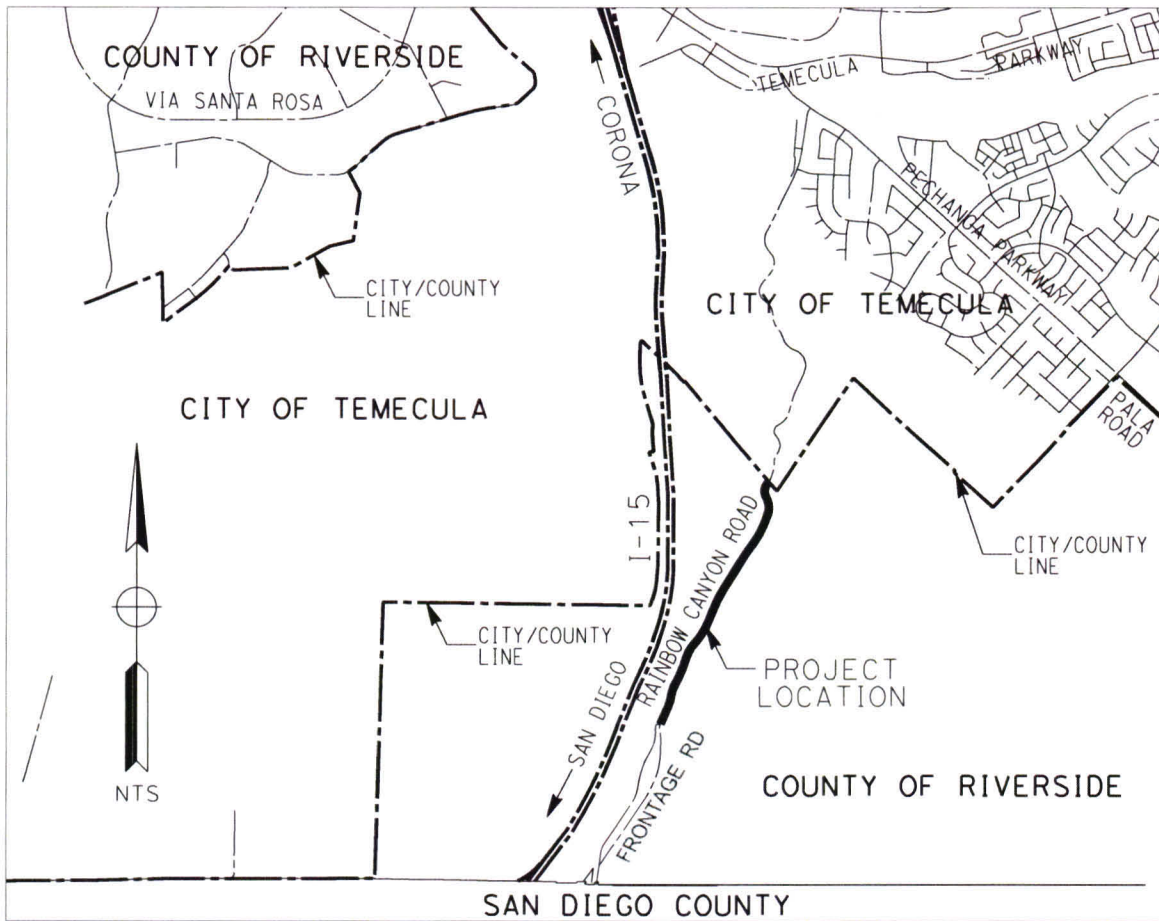
