## BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA ORDINANCE NO. 452.249 AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 452 RELATING TO PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:  
Section 1. Section 2.2 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Thirty miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsections 42, 43, and 44 to read as follows:

- "42. On Grant Street between Barker Lane and 1000 feet west of Somerdale Street, a total distance of approximately 0.10 miles, in the Home Gardens area.  
43. On High Country Circle between Olive Street and 1260 feet east of Western Crest Drive, a total distance of approximately 0.45 miles, in the Perris area.  
44. On Indiana Avenue between Neece Street and Barker Lane, a total distance of approximately 0.75 miles, in the Home Gardens area."

Section 2. Section 2.4 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Forty miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsection 160, to read as follows:

"160. On Indiana Avenue between 1000 feet west of Somerdale Street and 150 feet east of Hillview Drive (City of Riverside limits), a total distance of approximately 1.15 miles, in the Home Gardens area."

Section 3. Section 2.5 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Forty-five miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsections 191 and 192 to read as follows:

"191. On 70th Avenue between Windward Drive and Sea View Way, a total distance of approximately 1.1 miles, in the Mecca area.

192. On Central Avenue between I-215 westbound off-ramp and Sycamore Canyon Boulevard, a total distance of approximately 0.14 miles, in the University City area.

192. On Sea View Way between 72nd Avenue and 70th Avenue, a total distance of approximately 1.1 miles, in the Mecca area.

192. On Watkins Drive between 250 feet north of Gernert Road (City of Riverside limits) and I-215 westbound off-ramp, a total distance of approximately 0.15 miles, in the University City area."

Section 4. Section 2.7 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Fifty-five miles per hour," is hereby amended to add new subsection 33 to read as follows:

"33. On Central Avenue between Sycamore Canyon Boulevard and 815 feet west of Sycamore Canyon Boulevard (City of Riverside limits), a total distance of approximately 0.15 miles, in the University City area."

Section 5. Subsection 3 of Section 2.1 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 04, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 3 of Section 2.1 established a twenty-five miles per hour speed limit on Avenue Juan Bautista between Limonite Avenue and Avenue De Palma, in the Jurupa Hills area.

Section 6. Subsection 8 of Section 2.2 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 04, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 8 of Section 2.2 established a thirty miles per hour speed limit on Maitri Road between the centerline of Temescal Canyon Road and a point 4,000 feet south of Temescal Canyon Road, a total distance of approximately 0.75 mile, in the Glen Ivy area.

Section 7. Subsection 11 of Section 2.2 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 04, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 11 of Section 2.2 established a thirty miles per hour speed limit on Indiana Avenue between Somerdale Street and Neece Street, a total distance of approximately 0.5 miles, in the Home Gardens area.

Section 8. Subsection 95 of Section 2.3 of Ordinance 452 adopted on June 02, 2009, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.225, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 95 of Section 2.3 established a thirty-five miles per hour speed limit on El Nido Road between the centerline of Piedras Road and its easterly terminus, a total distance of approximately 0.44 miles, in the Perris area.

Section 9. Subsection 5 of Section 2.4 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 04, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 5 of Section 2.4 established a forty miles per hour speed limit on Indiana Avenue between the city limits of the City of Riverside and Somerdale Street, a total distance of approximately 1.1 miles, in the Home Gardens area.

Section 10. Subsection 44 of Section 2.5 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 04, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 44 of Section 2.5 established a forty-five miles per hour speed limit on Central Avenue between the centerline of State Route 60 westbound off-ramp and the centerline of Sycamore Canyon Boulevard, a total distance of approximately 480 feet, in the University City area.

Section 11. Subsection 43 of Section 2.5 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 04, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 43 of Section 2.5 established a forty-five miles per hour speed limit on Watkins Drive between the southerly boundary of the city limits of Riverside and the centerline of State Route 60 westbound off-ramp, a total distance of approximately 785 feet, in the University City area.

Section 12. Subsection 187 of Section 2.5 of Ordinance 452 is repealed in its entirety.

Section 13. Subsection 6 of Section 2.7 of Ordinance 452 adopted on February 04, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 6 of Section 2.7 established a fifty-five miles per hour speed limit on Central Avenue between Sycamore Canyon Boulevard and the city limits of Riverside, a total distance of approximately 0.25 mile, in the University City area.

Section 14. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.
