BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to the **Lions Club of Corona** will be used to cover expenses for this year's pancake breakfast and allow them to use all the income from the pancake breakfast to build up their scholarship fund for the next year's High School Scholarships.
2. The donation to **Support Sisterz** will be used to provide vital expenses that insurance and the survivors can't pay. Support Sisterz have found insurance does not always cover all the costs for surgeries and many women have large co-payments for medicine, surgeries, radiation, or prosthetics. During cancer treatment and surgeries some women are unable to work, which puts them in financial hardship. The need is different for each woman, but a lot of women need grocery cards, co-payments or even Cobra expenses paid for.
3. The donation to **Voices for Children** will fund the recruitment, training, and supervision of CASA volunteers providing advocacy for two Second District children in foster care. VFC's CASA program promotes each child's safety, stability, and quality of life by linking them to appropriate services and supports and representing their best interest through court and community advocacy.
