**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Jurupa Valley City Council approved the Third Amendment to the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services. This is the Third Amendment with the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services and the City of Jurupa Valley approved and executed this Third Amendment on behalf of its citizens. The City of Jurupa Valley has requested one (1) new Deputy Sheriff PCN to accommodate this request. County Counsel has approved the Third Amendment as to form.

Sheriff's staff anticipates this change will result in an estimated increase of \$1,427,000 in Contract Law Enforcement Revenue for FY22/23. The Department is recommending these budget adjustments now as it could not anticipate the addition in expenditures and include them in its FY22/23 budget.

A four-fifths vote is required for this item pursuant to California Government Code Section 29130 as a budget adjustment has been requested.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

This is the Third Amendment with the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services and the City of Jurupa Valley approved and executed this Third Amendment on behalf of its citizens. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates.

LEVEL OF SERVICE

Average Patrol Services

180 fully supported hours per day (Approximate equivalent of 35 Deputy Sheriff positions @ 1,884 annual productive hours per position).

Dedicated Positions

Six (6) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) positions – Zone Policing Officers

Four (4) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) positions – Traffic Enforcement Officers

Five (5) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) positions – Motorcycle Enforcement Officers

Two (2) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) positions – Community Oriented Policing

Seven (7) Community Service Officer positions – Traffic Enforcement/Patrol
