MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA



On motion of Supervisor Jeffries seconded by Supervisor Washington, and duly carried by unanimous vote, IT WAS ORDERED that the meeting of Tuesday, August 30, 2022, be adjourned in memory of Carmen Ramirez, Ventura County Board of Supervisors Chair, who was struck and killed by a vehicle while walking through a crosswalk in Oxnard. She was 73 years old.

Carmen Ramirez was born in Oklahoma, where her father, a sixth-generation Mexican American from California, was stationed during World War II, with her mother, a Swedish-Irish-English-American. Carmen grew up in Pico Rivera, California and graduated from Loyola Law School. Carmen moved to Oxnard in 1978 to coordinate the Self-Help Legal Access Center in the town's Colonia neighborhood, which was "across the tracks" from the city's downtown area.

Carmen was a trustee for the Colleges of Law for Santa Barbara and Ventura. She taught courses in landlord-tenant law, consumer law, and collaborative advocacy. She was on the executive committee of the California Bench Bar Coalition, which advocates for public access to justice.

Carmen Ramirez was the county's first Latino supervisor and board chair. She continuously fought for Medicare for all, women's reproductive rights, and human rights, alongside civil rights leaders, and farm workers. She was known, among other things, as a passionate advocate for the environment. She served on the Oxnard City Council for 10 years before she was elected to the county's Board of Supervisors in 2020.

Carmen Ramirez previously served as President of the Ventura County Bar Association and was also elected to the State Bar of California's board of governors. She served as a board member for the Center for Civic Education and was appointed to the Commission on State Mandates by Governor Jerry Brown in 2012. Carmen was passionate about the environmental justice and creating a better future for the community. Her Kindness, love and deep compassion was felt by everyone.

Carmen Ramirez's memory and passionate spirit will live forever in the hearts of those who knew and loved her. She will be greatly missed but never forgotten.
