

**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Voices for Children - \$10,000** funding will be used to support the efforts with the Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASAs) program. VFC will provide children with a CASA who will advocate for their education, vocational, physical, and mental health, housing stability, and other needs.
  
- 2. Spanish Town Heritage Foundation - \$2,500** funds will be used to support the annual Tamale Festival, a cultural event, with the goal of education and outreach about the Trujillo Adobe and Spanish Town area.
  
- 3. Riverside County Works c/o Jamil Dada Character Excellence Youth Awards Ceremony - \$2,500** funds will be allocated to support Riverside County Workforce Investment Board's Scholarship Program at the Annual Character Counts Youth Awards Ceremony.
  
- 4. Feed My Flock Ministries - \$2,000** funds will be used to support the ministries efforts to provide Welcome Home Baskets to newly housed homeless individuals in program-based organizations. The baskets contain household items to get the individuals started in their new home.
