

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Each year, the Coalition for Clean Air organizes California Clean Air Day, a statewide event that encourages individuals and organizations to commit to improving the environment, through actions big and small. The 2022 California Clean Air Day will be held on October 5, 2022 and the Inland Empire Working Group is working to promote local events and activities and form partnerships to increase participation in California Clean Air Day throughout the Inland Empire region.

The Coalition for Clean Air awards microgrants of \$1,000 to local projects that raise awareness of Clean Air Day, engage community members in events and activities that contribute to cleaning the air, and encourage participants to take actions that clean the air. CID funds will be used to support the Coalition for Clean Air's microgrant program for the Inland Empire region.
