She was a certified Director of Music, by the United Methodist Church. Marjorie served churches in Pennsylvania, North Carolina, and South Carolina. She founded the Brunswick County North Carolina Ecumenical choir Festival in 1993.

Marjorie traveled to Zian, China and Prampram, Ghana, West Africa as a Global Volunteer, serving as a member of teams teaching in schools in those cities. She was a team member, sponsored by Habitat for Humanity near Mexico City, Mexico.

After moving to Corona, California, Marjorie served as Program and Scholarship Chairwoman for the Woman's Improvement Club of Corona. She was the keyboardist for the First Congregational Church and Peace Lutheran Church in Corona.

On motion of Supervisor Spiegel seconded by Supervisor Washington, and duly carried by unanimous vote, IT WAS ORDERED that the meeting of Tuesday, September 13, 2022, be adjourned in memory of Queen Elizabeth II, who passed away at her Scottish estate, Thursday, September 8, 2022, at the age of 96.

Queen Elizabeth II of the United Kingdom and other Commonwealth realms from February 6, 1952 until her death in 2022. She was queen regnant of 32 sovereign states during her lifetime and 15 at the time of her death. Her reign of 70 years and 214 days is the longest of any British monarch, the longest recorded of any female head of state in history, and the second-longest verified reign of any monarch in history.

The Queen was a creature of habit and seemed inherently fastidious. She followed a calendar that changed little over the years. She resided, variously, at Buckingham Palace or her preferred Windsor Castle. She decamped to Windsor permanently at the start of the covid-19 pandemic. At Balmoral and Sandringham, the public got glimpses of how Queen Elizabeth might have lived had she not become queen: as a well-heeled English countrywoman in green wellies leading a gaggle of muddy Welsh corgis.

Queen Elizabeth II had a small and discreet circle of friends and relatives with whom she could decompress to from a public life, but even they would curtsy in greeting to her, and she maintained a certain distance.

Queen Elizabeth II, will be buried in her final resting place next to Prince Philip, her husband of more than 70 years. She will be greatly missed but never forgotten.

Susan received an Associate of Arts Degree, from Los Angeles, City College in 1954, a Bachelor's Degree, from California State University, Los Angeles in 1956 and a Master's Degree, from California State University, San Bernardino 1978.

Susan was an Elementary school teacher for grades K-8<sup>th</sup>. She was an Elementary Education Specialist on a UCR research project evaluating desegregated schools. She was an Instructional Coordinator for (ESAA) Emergency School Aid Act, Project Jurupa Unified School District, and a Consultant for Mc Grew Hill Publishing Company.

Susan was an active member of the community. In addition to her involvement with the Riverside African American Historical Society, Susan was one of the founders, and first president of the Riverside African American Historical Society, she was a docent at the Riverside Metropolitan Museum and co-founder and founding president of the museum's Multi Cultural Council.

Susan was a member of Riverside First Baptist Church, a member of the Riverside International Relation Council, and the California Retired Teachers Association. Susan was a life member of The Riverside NAACP, Sickle Cell Organization, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, as well as the African American Historical Society.
