2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Girard Street Resurfacing and Acacia Avenue Drainage Repair and Resurfacing Projects, in the Community of East Hemet;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, October 12, 2022 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface approximately 1.75 miles of Girard Street from the Ramona Bowl Entry Gate to Florida Avenue (State Highway 74), and to construct drainage improvements and to resurface approximately 0.15 miles of Acacia Avenue from approximately 580-feet west of Marlo Court to 225-feet east of Marlo Court, in the Community of East Hemet of Riverside County.

Girard Street is classified as a secondary highway road in the County of Riverside's General Plan. Girard Street is a two-lane road servicing vehicular traffic that travel in the north and south directions, and its width varies between 22-feet to 64-feet.

The proposed segment of Acacia Avenue is classified as a local street in the County of Riverside's General Plan. Acacia Avenue is a two-lane road servicing vehicular traffic that travel in the east and west directions, and at this segment, its width varies between 22-feet to 26-feet.

Two projects are combined to bid as one project in order to gain cost efficiencies by eliminating multiple bidding and administrative procedures and to seek more favorable bids associated with larger bid quantities.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. Mainly, the proposed resurfacing of Girard Street consists of removing the existing asphalt concrete pavement and underlying material and placing back cement stabilized soil and new Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement. The proposed resurfacing of Acacia Avenue consists of two treatment types. The first treatment consists of removing the existing asphalt concrete pavement and underlying material and placing back class 2 aggregate base, designed to compact firmly, and HMA pavement. The second treatment consists of grinding down a portion of the existing asphalt concrete pavement followed by overlaying back with HMA.

Additional improvements include placement of asphalt concrete dike, construction of asphalt concrete driveways, construction of concrete curb and gutter, sidewalk, Americans with

Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant curb ramps, cross gutter and spandrels, residential and commercial driveways, construction of pavement safety edge to protect outside edge of pavement, installation of traffic striping, thermoplastic crosswalk, installation of traffic signs, and other associated work.

Drainage improvements on Acacia Avenue consist of constructing a storm drain system to convey storm water from the south side of Acacia Avenue to an existing ephemeral earth channel located on the north side of Acacia Avenue easterly of Marlo Court. Storm drain system includes installation of 18-inch and 24-inch high-density polyethylene (HDPE) storm drainpipe with watertight joints, 36-inch by 36-inch precast drop inlet, construction of concrete headwall, wing walls, apron, and energy dissipator.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

Base Bid 1:	Girard Street Resurfacing
Alternative Bid 1:	City of Hemet (City Limit to Florida Avenue)
Alternative Bid 2:	Frontier Communications Facilities Adjustments
Alternative Bid 3:	Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) Facilities Adjustments
Base Bid 2:	Acacia Avenue Drainage Repair and Resurfacing

Improvements within the City of Hemet are included in the bid package as an alternate bid schedule. If the City of Hemet approves the award of their alternative bid schedule, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by the City of Hemet through a reimbursement Agreement, which will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval prior to or concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

The adjustment of facilities owned by Frontier and EMWD, are also included in the bid package as alternative bid schedules. If Frontier and EMWD approve the award of their respective alternative bid schedules, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by the utility owners through reimbursement letter Agreements that will be executed by the Director of Transportation.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid for the sum of all bid schedules.

Environmental Findings

The projects propose to resurface approximately 1.75 miles of Girard Street and 0.15 miles of Acacia Avenue, construct curb ramps, curb and gutter, sidewalks, driveways, improve existing drainage facilities, and associated improvements. The projects in their entirety are consistent

with Section 15301(c) because they do not create additional automobile lanes and involve no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to replace existing deteriorated pavement with new hot mix asphalt for the approximate 1.75 miles segment of Girard Street and 0.15 miles segment of Acacia Avenue to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic. Drainage improvements will address water flows issues during rain events.

The work is scheduled to begin in winter 2022. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two and a half months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$4,541,753.

The County improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/HUTA and Gas Tax/SB-1 Funds. The City of Hemet, Frontier, and EMWD are responsible for funding their respective alternative bid schedules in full if approved.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

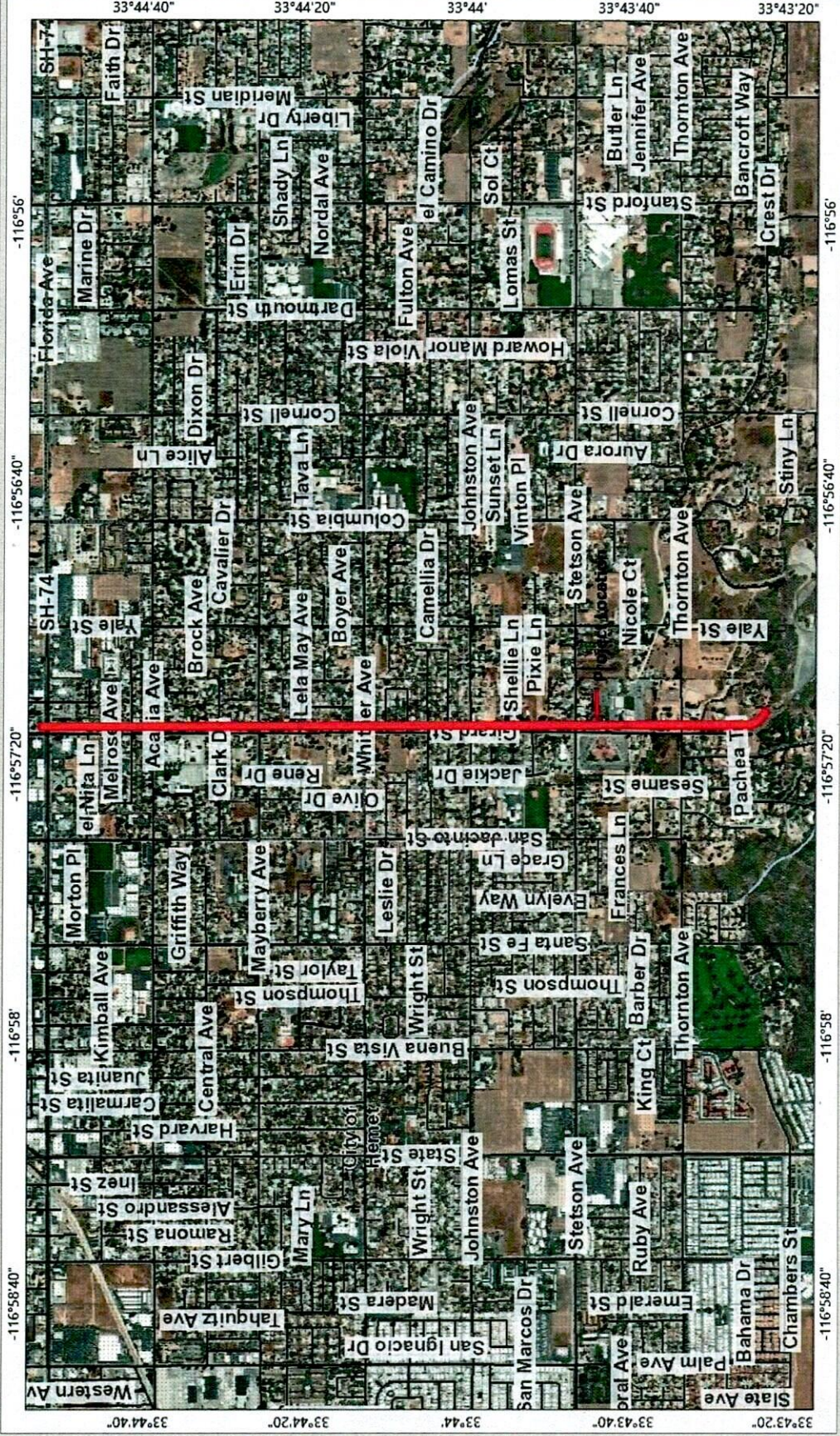

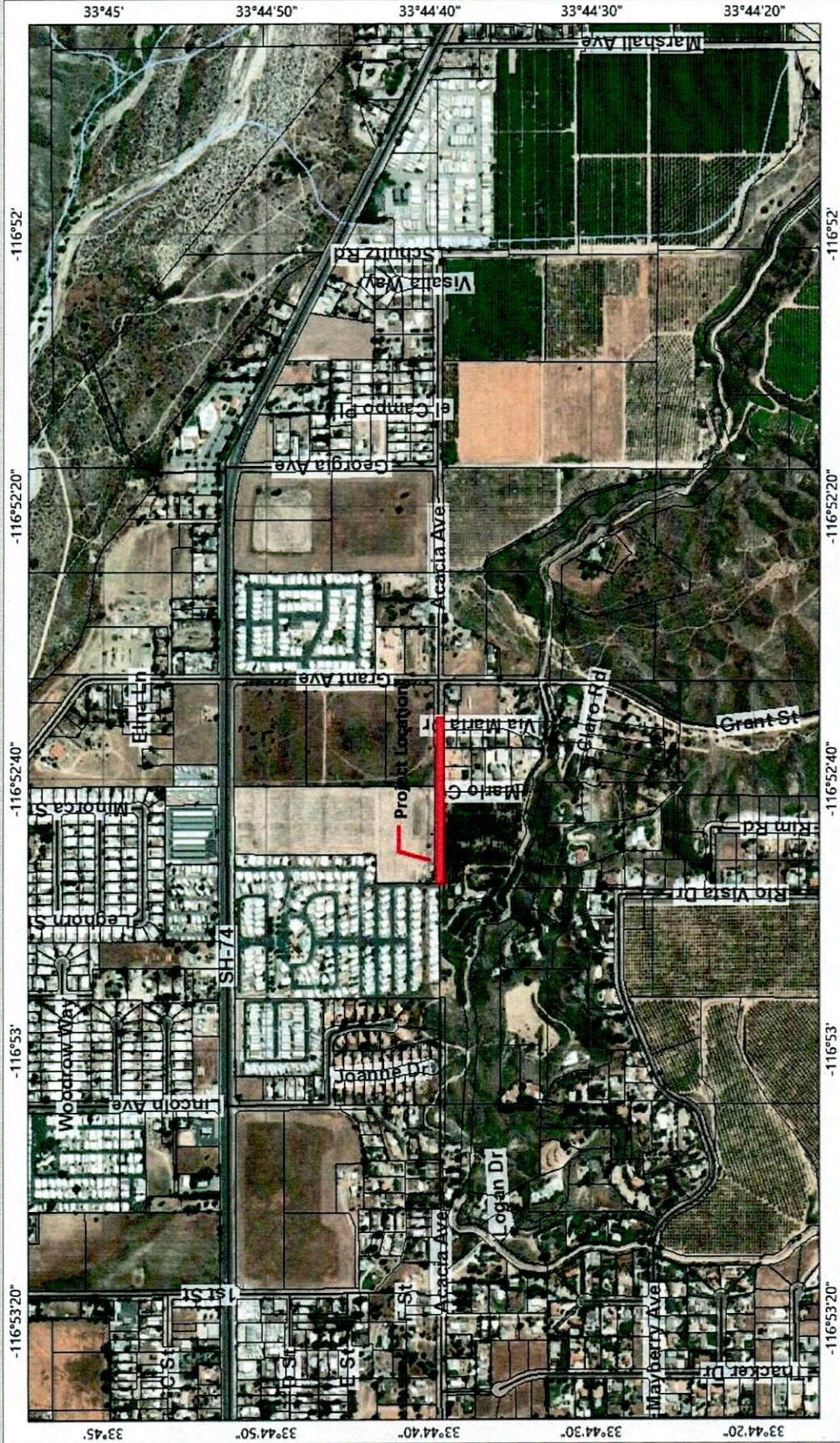

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface approximately 9,300 feet of Girard Street from The Ramona Bowl entry gate to Florida Ave. Girard Street is classified as a secondary highway in the County of Riverside's General Plan. Girard Street is a two-lane road and currently ranges from 22-64 feet wide with curb/gutter along various segments of the roadway. The proposed project will include removing the existing pavement, stabilizing the subgrade, and placing back Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA). A few segments of this project will be reconstructed to solve flooding issues.

Additional improvements for Girard Street include:

- Reconstruction of AC dikes
- Reconstruction of curb and gutter
- Reconstruction / relocation of cross gutter and spandrels
- Reconstruction of existing sidewalk
- Reconstruction of curb ramps type A, B and special ramps to meet current ADA standards.
- Reconstruction of AC and concrete driveways
- Reconstruction of existing mailboxes per USPS standards
- Reconstruction of existing fencing
- Placement of safety edge and shoulder backing
- Utility adjustments
- Regrade existing earthen swale
- Restriping of roadway, including pavement markers and reflectors
- Salvage/removal and installation of new signs
- Signal/Traffic light modification at Acacia E Ave/Girard St intersections

Also, the County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to reconstruct/resurface approximately 0.15 miles of Acacia Ave. Acacia Ave is classified as a Local Street in the County of Riverside's General Plan. Acacia Ave currently ranges from 22-26 feet wide with dike and over-side drains along various segments of the roadway. The proposed project will include excavating

459 feet of existing AC pavement, base and native material to prevent flooding upstream and reconstruct with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) and Class 2 Aggregate Base. A storm drain will be constructed to convey the flow to an existing drainage channel. AC pavement will be resurfaced 342 feet to the east.

The proposed project will also include:

- Construction of 4" mountable AC dike
- Placement of safety edge and shoulder backing
- Striping of roadway, including pavement markers and reflectors
- Salvage/removal and installation of new signs
- Installation of a storm drain system which will consist of (2) precast drain inlets, 18" dual walled high-density poly-ethylene (HDPE) storm drainpipe and fittings, 24" dual walled HDPE storm drainpipe and fittings, manhole, headwall (wing type) and rip-rap energy dissipator pad.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project will not acquire additional right-of-way. Temporary construction easements will not be required for the proposed improvements.

The project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County MSHCP. In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside/inside of cell criteria area/conservation areas. This project is considered to be operation and maintenance; therefore, it is a covered activity under the Western Riverside County MSHCP.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (February 15 – September 15), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The County of Riverside Transportation Department has found that the above-described project(s) is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The project proposes to reconstruct and resurface Girard Street from the Ramona Bowl entry gate to Florida Ave; and reconstruct and resurface 0.15 miles of Acacia Ave as well as improve existing drainage facilities. The project in its entirety is consistent with Section 15301(c) because it does not create additional traffic lanes and involves no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.
