**BACKGROUND:**

The State of the County has in the past been an annual event held to publicly highlight major happenings going on in and around our County, important projects and initiatives being led by our Board and implemented by County Departments, and present information about future projects. Due to the pandemic, the event was last held in 2019. It is an exciting time in Riverside County as we pursue many noteworthy endeavors in our fast-growing County (which continues to top the State in growth over the last few decades) and implement many efforts to enhance the delivery of County services that our constituents rely on. It is appropriate that we once-again resume this annual tradition, to publicly share information about the efforts that County government is taking to improve the lives of the public that we serve.

The event is proposed to be held on the morning of December 8, 2022 at Morongo, which has been a gracious host in the past of this event. A budget not-to-exceed \$75,000 is being requested for the costs of the event, which will be reduced by potential opportunities to lower costs through sponsorships or funding contributions.
