SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 970 AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE FOR THE ADOPTION OF A MILITARY EQUIPMENT USE POLICY, OTHERWISE REFERRED TO HEREIN AS A SPECIALIZED POLICE EQUIPMENT USE POLICY, PURSUANT TO ASSEMBLY BILL 481 AND GOVERNMENT CODE §7070 FOR THE OFFICES OF THE RIVERSIDE SHERIFF-CORONER- PUBLIC ADMINISTRATOR AND RIVERSIDE COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY.

This summary is presented pursuant to Government Code Section 25124(b). A certified copy of the full text of Ordinance No. 970 may be examined at the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, located at 4080 Lemon Street, 1st Floor, Riverside, California, 92501.

The County Board of Supervisors (BOS) will consider adopting Ordinance No. 970 in compliance with Assembly Bill 481 on Tuesday, March 8, 2022 during its regular scheduled board meeting. Ordinance No. 970 applies to both the Sheriff's and District Attorney's Office. Assembly Bill 481 requires the BOS during public hearing to either approve or amend their respective Military Equipment Use Policies (Use Policies). The legislative intent for this policy and subsequent hearings is to safeguard the public's welfare and provide a layer of transparency. A public hearing will take place to allow the public to voice any concerns on the county's adoption of the proposed Ordinance No. 970 as well as the District Attorney and Sheriff's Use Policies."
