BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

- 1. Riverside Medical Clinic Charitable Foundation- \$2,000 funding will be used to provide training to educators, law enforcement, youth leaders, and community representatives who are committed to ending bullying.
- 2. Riverside County Foundation on Aging \$3,000 funds will be used to assist the Foundation with their Holiday Gift Program.
