NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, in regular session assembled on October 18, 2022, located on the first floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the District Attorney of the County of Riverside, or designee, on behalf of the County, to sign and submit the Grant Agreement (the "Agreement") on behalf of the Board of Supervisors, as well as related amendments, or extensions with DOI, as approved by County Counsel. This resolution shall be in effect for a three-year period beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2025.

IT IS AGREED that any liability arising out of the performance of this Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and DOI disclaim responsibility of any such liability. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant local expenditures controlled by this body.
