**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The City of Palm Springs is hosting their Veterans Day Parade celebration on November 11, 2022. This parade honors all who served and provides an opportunity for the community to say thank you to all our veterans for their service. CID funds will be used towards parade expenses.
2. HOPE is a nonprofit, nonpartisan organization committed to ensure political and economic parity for Latinas through leadership, advocacy, and education to benefit all communities and the status of women. HOPE is hosting Latina Empowerment Day on October 28, 2022, a one-day intensive workshop created to empower Latinas to increase their community impact and strengthen their skills and knowledge. CID funds will be used towards this event.
3. Riverside University Health System will host the 33<sup>rd</sup> Annual Festival of Trees on November 22, 2022. This event raises funds to support the critical work at RUHS Pediatric Unit, Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, Pediatric Intensive Care Unit and the Child Abuse a Neglect Unit. CID funds will be used to support the transition of the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) into a Quiet Unit.
