BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Riverside County Fire Department (RCFD) is requesting asset authorization to purchase a scenario trailer for its Public Information & Media Relations Bureau as part of the grant funded Juvenile Fire Intervention Program (JFIP). On December 14, 2021 via Minute Order No. 3.23 the Board approved FY21 CalFIRE California Climate Investments Fire Prevention Grant Agreement No. 5GG20165 for the JFIP which included the purchase of a scenario trailer to allow for continued interactive participation and community educational outreach.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

JFIP uses collaborative and educational approaches with minors and their parents/guardians in the County of Riverside as an opportunity for families to work with our department and address any concerns regarding their children and fire. This trailer is one layer of the educational program which will provide interactive scenarios about how to react in a fire situation, use of fire extinguishers, fire prevention safety and much more. The trailer will be transported to schools and public events to enhance the message of fire safety to the community.

Additional Fiscal Information

This asset is included in the approved grant budget in the amount of \$212,564 for the purchase of the equipment. Any future maintenance costs will be captured in the department's operating budget. Once the asset is authorized, the item will be processed by RCFD using the established County purchasing procedures via our purchasing section. If a budget adjustment is needed once the final cost of the trailer is identified through the solicitation process, RCFD will return to the Board for that action.
