Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, November 16, 2022, at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing storm drain improvements and repair of a deep erosion gully present on the natural slopes below 44980 Viejo Drive in the Community of East Hemet of Riverside County.

A large erosion gully has developed downslope of the rear yard of Lot 7 (44980 Viejo Drive) of Tract No. 3300 as a result of discharge from a 24-inch-diameter corrugated metal pipe (CMP) storm drain. The erosion has occurred over many years and has progressively deepened and widened during repeat cycles of stormwater discharge.

Tract No. 3300, including Lot 7 (44980 Viejo Drive), was approved for grading in 1965. There is a roughly 100-foot-high descending slope behind the lot. A drainage inlet and 24-inch CMP was installed to collect runoff from the cul-de-sac on Viejo Drive, convey it along the boundary between Lots 6 and 7, and discharge it to a lined ditch on the slope. The erosion started when the lined ditch was undermined and washed out, and since that time the CMP has discharged directly onto the slope resulting in progressively deeper erosion and the deep gully which is present today.

Mainly, the proposed project will consist of installing approximately 175-feet of 24-inch reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) to convey stormwater down slope and restoring an approximately 0.23 Acre area of the eroded gully with suitable local and imported fill material.

Additional improvements include removal and proper disposal of debris and existing on-site unsuitable material, slope regrading, placement of subdrain, placement of soil reinforcement geogrid layers to reinforce and stabilize the slope, construction of concrete manhole, construction of concrete stormwater energy dissipator, placement of rock slope protection, hydroseeding and netting on the final slope face and adjacent areas to provide protection from surface erosion.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

The project proposes to improve storm drain and repair a deep erosion gully present on the natural slopes below 44980 Viejo Drive in the Community of East Hemet, and associated improvements. The project in its entirety is consistent with State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(c) because it does not involve expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to improve existing storm drain by installing reinforced concrete pipe to convey stormwater down slope and restoring an approximately 0.23 Acre area of the eroded gully. Drainage improvements will address water flows issues and prevent further slope erosion during rain events.

The work is scheduled to begin in winter 2022. The work will take approximately two-and-a-half months to complete.

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$797,224.

The County improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/HUTA Funds.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to construct a storm drainpipe and restore the eroded slope face located behind 44980 Viejo Drive on Viejo Drive approximately 800 feet east of Rim Road. The proposed project will consist of constructing a 24" reinforced concrete pipe that connects to the existing corrugated metal pipe (CMP) and placing fill to restore the eroded gully.

- Regrading of the slope
- Placement of subdrain
- Placement of geogrid
- Construction of manhole
- Construction of rock energy dissipater
- Hydroseeding

A Temporary Construction Easement and rights of entry on Grand Ave to access the project site will be obtained. Following procurement of the right-of-way access to Grant Avenue, a single temporary crossing will be constructed to transverse the unnamed streambed and access the toe of slope of the erosional feature.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). In accordance with Section 7.1 (*Covered Activities Outside Criteria Area and PQP Lands*) of the WRCMSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered to be a covered activity outside of cell criteria areas and/or outside of conservation areas. This project is considered to be an operation and maintenance activity; therefore, it is a covered activity under the Western Riverside County MSHCP. The project will comply with the construction guidelines provided in Section 7.5.3, as well as Best Management Practices (BMPs) outlined in Appendix C.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (February 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act of 1918 (MBTA) and California Fish and Game Codes Section 3503, 3503.5, 3513, and 3800.

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301(c) – Existing Facilities – The proposed maintenance activity will repair a culvert and associated eroded gully. The slope has progressively deepened and widened during repeat cycles of stormwater discharge. Due to the steep grade of the hillside where the erosion is located, and to prevent future erosion, the proposed activity will reconstruct, stabilize, and protect the slope, and install a 24" CMP pipe that ties into the existing 24" storm drainpipe and extended to the toe of the slope to contain the stormwater.

The project in its entirety is consistent with Section 15301(c) because the project involves repairing an existing culvert to protect private property and public facilities.

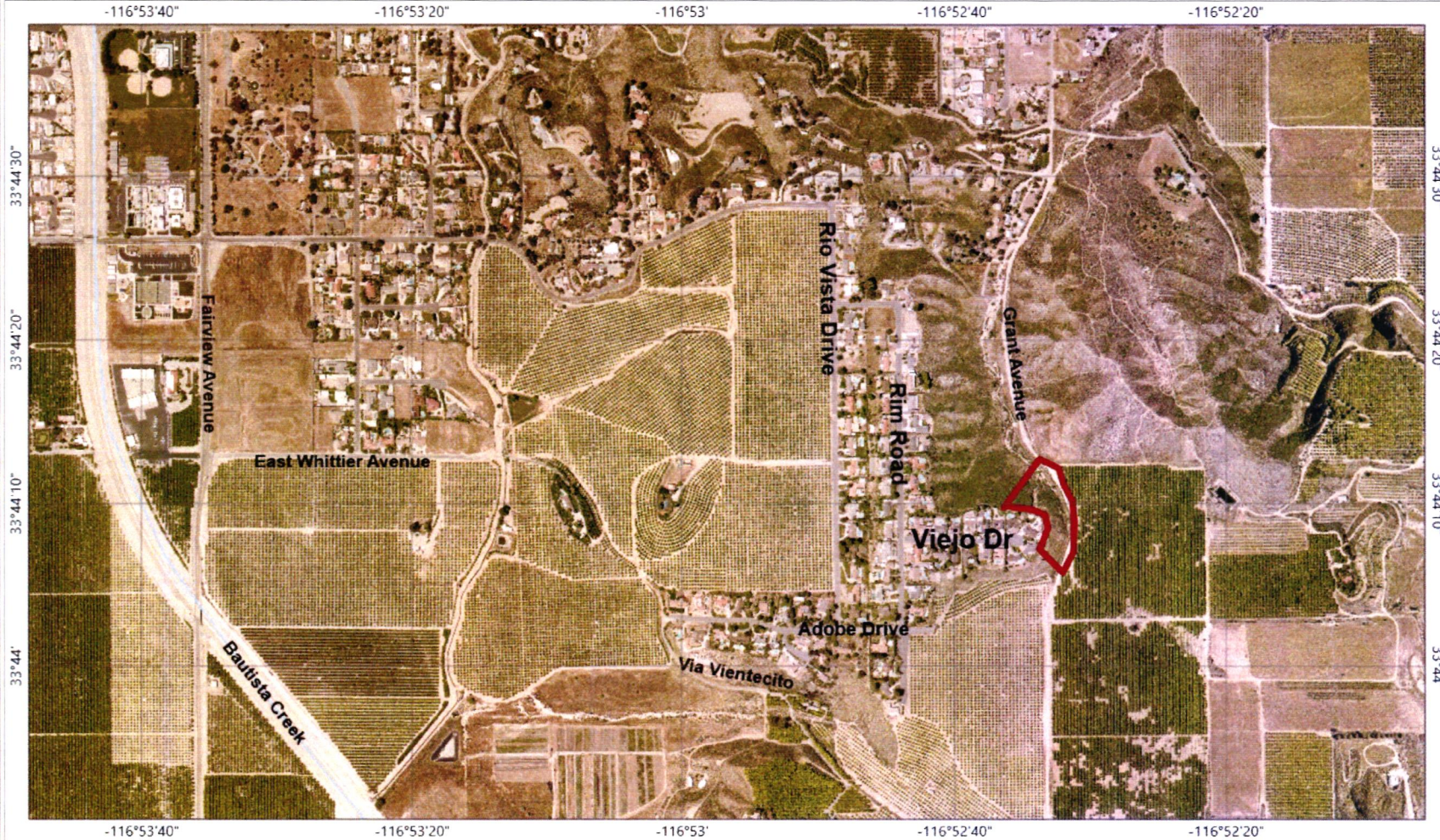

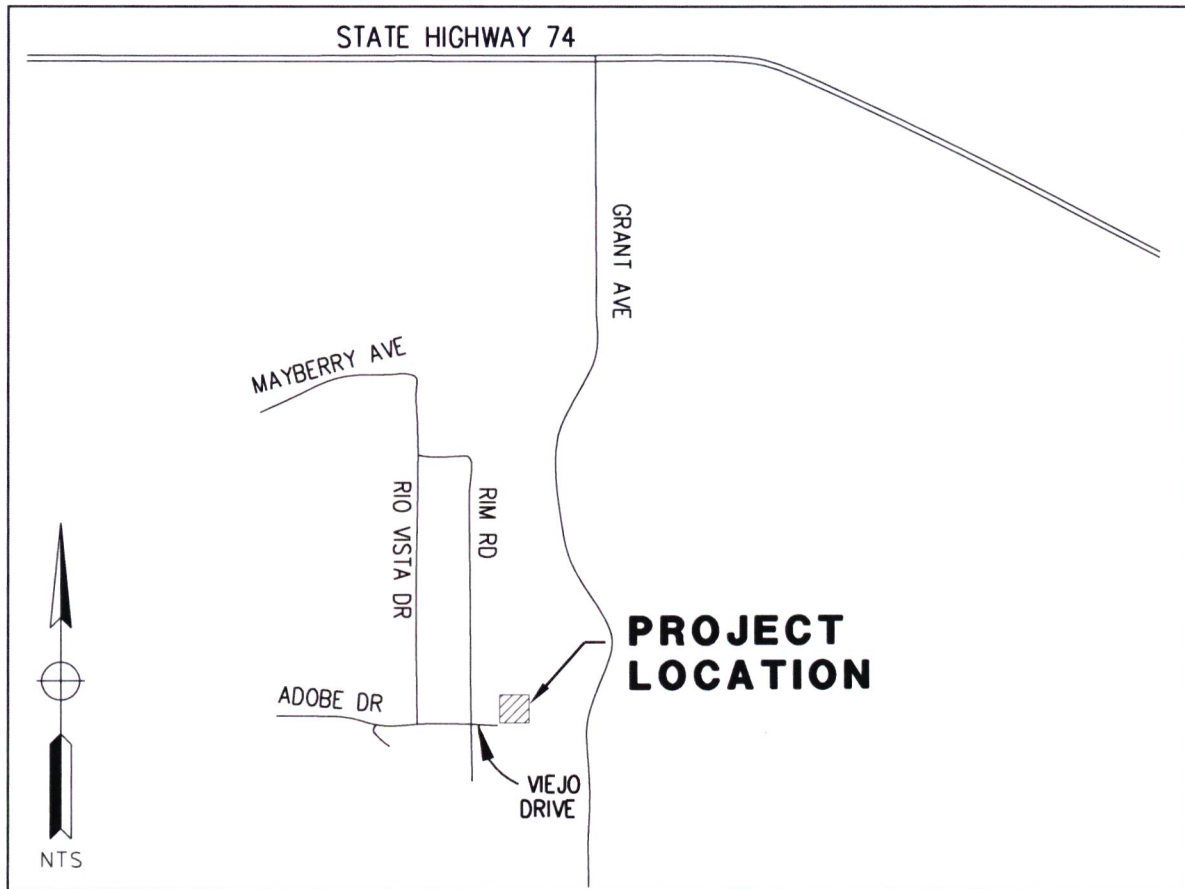
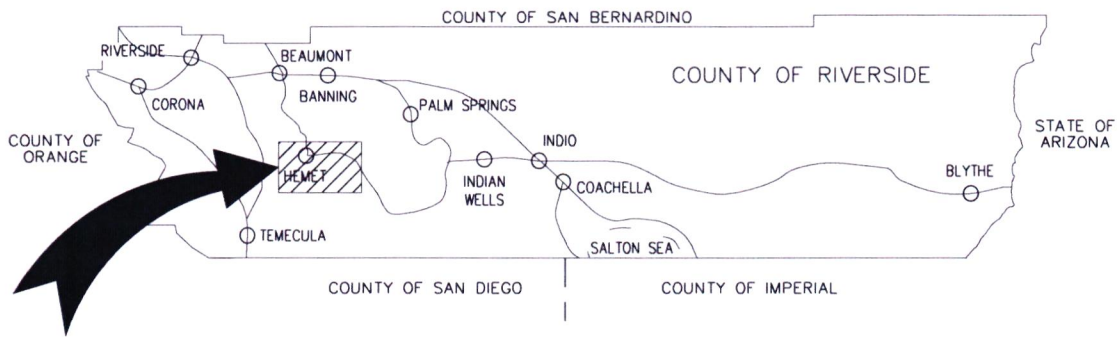
