BACKGROUND:

Dr. Arnold Tabuenca has served as Chief Medical Officer of RUHS Medical Center since 1995, inspiring and training generations of new physicians to provide compassionate high-quality care to all individuals, expanding medical residency training and leading the medical center through numerous challenges and changes, including the recent COVID-19 pandemic.

The 200,000 square-foot Medical Surgical Center opened in 2020 to accommodate the growing need for additional outpatient surgery suites, pediatrics and multiple outpatient services and clinics. The three-story MSC building is linked by a bridge to the medical center facility.
