Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, November 23, 2022, at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department proposes to install desert tortoise fence at their Midland Gravel Pit (Midland Borrow Pit or Midland Pit) located north of the City of Blythe, off the Blythe-Midland Road, approximately three miles north of Interstate 10.

The County of Riverside Transportation Department has a free-use permit to mine sand and gravel with the Bureau of Land Management on Federal land located on a portion of Section 30 of Township 5 south, Range 23 east (Midland Gravel Pit location).

The mined sand and gravel are used for the construction and maintenance of County roads in the Blythe area.

The Midland Gravel Pit is located within the boundaries of the critical habitat area for the Desert Tortoise. The existence of the Desert Tortoise is mitigated by primarily not mining in the wash areas where the tortoises are prone to exist and secondarily by employing conservation measures.

Mainly, the proposed project will consist of installing approximately 8,000-feet of Desert Tortoise fence around the perimeter of the Midland Gravel Pit (Phase 2) and access road to exclude tortoise from areas where they might be struck by vehicles.

The submitted specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include one bid schedule of work.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Environmental Findings

**SUBMITTAL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

The project proposes to install approximately 8,000-feet of Desert Tortoise exclusion fence around the perimeter of the Midland Gravel Pit (Phase 2). An authorized biologist will survey for desert tortoise prior to permanent desert tortoise fencing being installed around the expansion area. A biologist will also monitor all fence construction activities. Once fence construction is complete, an authorized biologist will perform clearance surveys for desert tortoise within the fenced areas. The project in its entirety is consistent with State CEQA Guidelines Section 15308 because it consists of actions taken to assure the maintenance, restoration, enhancement, or protection of the environment.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The sand and gravel mined from the Midland Gravel Pit is used by the County of Riverside Transportation Department for the construction and maintenance of County roads in the Blythe area. The purpose of this project is to exclude tortoise from areas in the Midland Gravel Pit where they might be struck by vehicles.

The work is scheduled to begin in winter 2022. The work will take approximately one month to complete.

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT: 4

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department is expanding the existing Midland Materials Pit, for mining sand and gravel. A permanent desert tortoise exclusion fence will be placed around the expansion area. Approximately 1.5 miles of fence will be constructed, around 7,712 feet. This encompasses approximately 25.47 acres. An authorized biologist will survey for desert tortoise prior to permanent desert tortoise fencing being installed around the expansion area. A biologist will also monitor all fence construction activities. Once fence construction is complete, an authorized biologist will perform clearance surveys for desert tortoise within the fenced areas.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

For the Federal and State listed desert tortoise, Biological Opinion FWS-ERIV-1813.3 has been obtained from the US Fish and Wildlife Service, 2080.1 take permit has been obtained from the California Department of Fish and Wildlife and Free Use permit number CACA57679 has been obtained from the US Bureau of Land Management addressing the active pit and its expansion.

Temporary construction easements will not be required.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (February 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act of 1918 (MBTA) and California Fish and Game Codes Section 3503, 3503.5, 3513, and 3800.

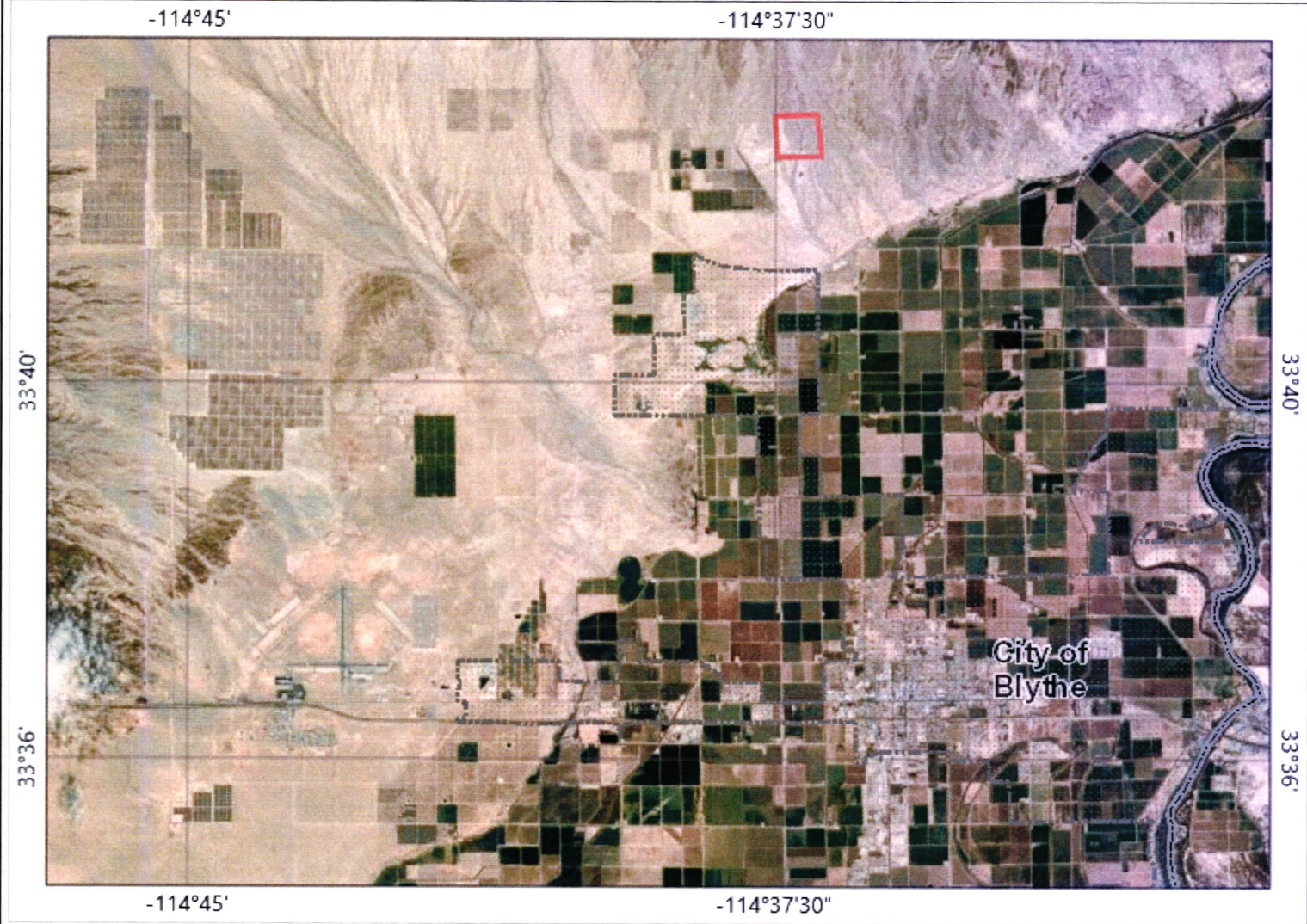

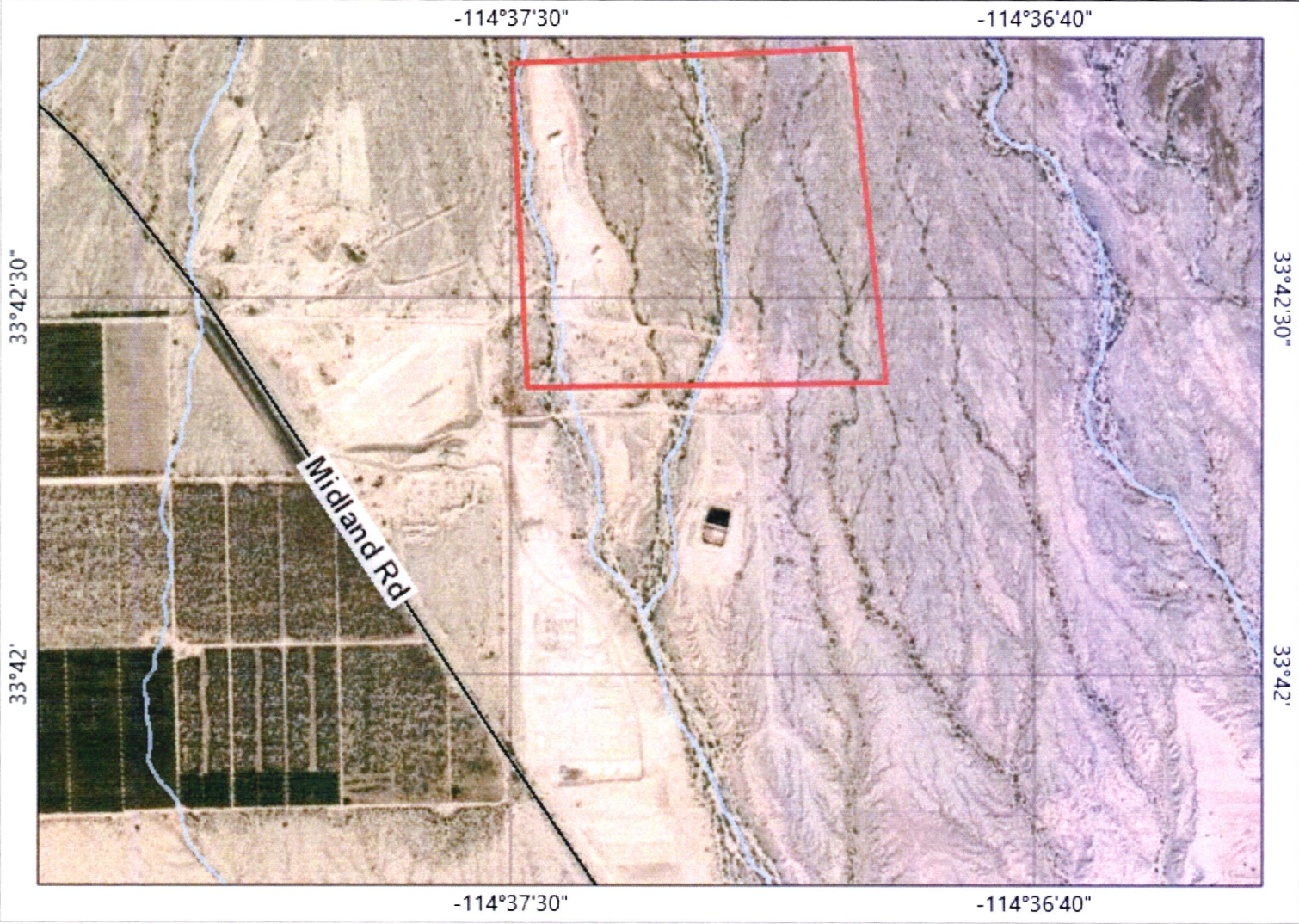

Midland Materials Pit-Closeup

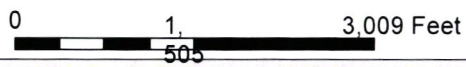

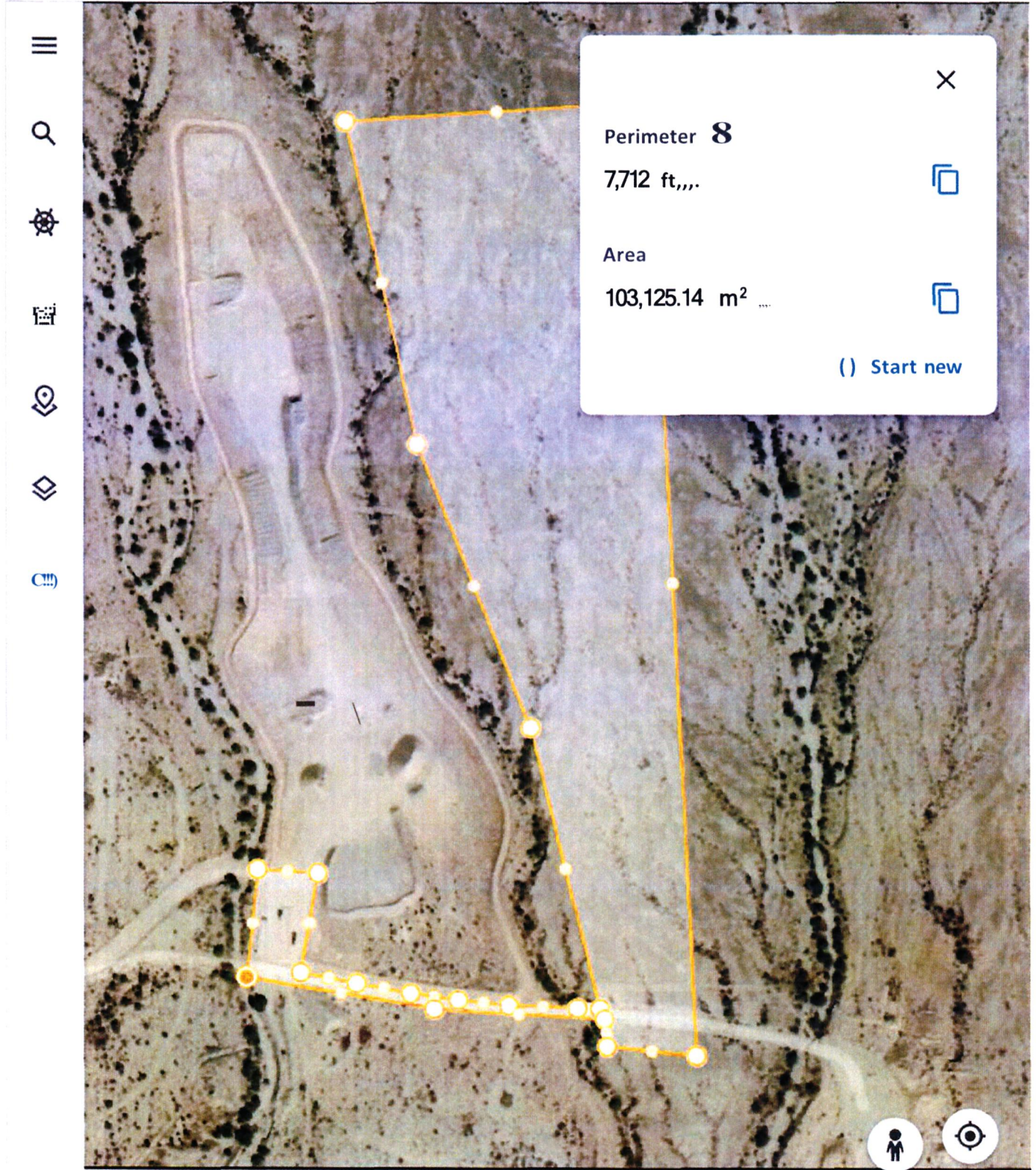


