**SUBJECT:** RIVERSIDE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SYSTEM - BEHAVIORAL HEALTH: Ratify and Approve the Grant Subcontract Agreement No. 7469-BHCIP-County of Riverside-01G with Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. for County and Tribal Planning Grant in the amount of \$150,000 for the period January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022 and Adopt Resolution No. 2022-193, All Districts. 

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

Riverside University Health System - Behavioral Health (RUHS-BH) operates a continuum of care system that consists of County-operated and contracted service providers delivering a variety of mental health treatment services within each geographic region of Riverside County.

On Tuesday, January 25, 2022 (Item 3.48), the Board of Supervisors approved RUHS-BH to submit grant applications to California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) for the Behavioral Health Continuum Infrastructure Program (BHCIP) funding.

RUHS-BH submitted a grant application to DHCS for the BHCIP County and Tribal Planning Round Two Grant, and was awarded \$150,000 by DHCS, for the period of January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022, to expand planning efforts in communities or regions for the acquisition and expansion of behavioral health infrastructure. The funds are intended to support a portion of costs for planning efforts of the Recovery Villages and the new Behavioral Health Hospital. Advocates for Human Potential (AHP), Inc. is the contractor administering the grant on behalf of DHCS.

RUHS-BH proposes to expand infrastructure capacity by adding these facilities to various locations within Riverside County. This expansion will allow RUHS-BH to add capacity for acute inpatient psychiatric care, residential treatment services, sub-acute treatment, Substance Use Disorder (SUD) treatment facilities, children’s mental health services, as well as housing the homeless population. Planning efforts for these facilities include schematic designs, design development and construction documents.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

These planning efforts will provide Riverside County residents with the means to provide these needed services to some of the county’s most vulnerable populations.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

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The grant award in the amount of \$150,000 from FY 2021/22 through FY 2022/23. There are sufficient appropriations in the Department's budget for the expenditure. No additional County funds are being requested at this time.



**BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on October 18, 2022, that the Board of Supervisors approves and accepts Agreement #7469-BHCIP-County of Riverside-01G between the Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. (AHP) and Riverside University Health System-Behavioral Health (RUHS-BH) and authorizes:

1. The Director of Behavioral Health to accept and sign documents related to Agreement #7469-BHCIP-County of Riverside-01G and administer the grant. This authority shall include signature of necessary acceptance documents and amendments that otherwise increase or modify the agreement, exhibits, certifications and reports. Amendments shall be approved by County counsel;
2. The Director of Behavioral Health shall promptly report to the Board all funding changes for budget and Auditor Controller purposes and any material changes or significant new developments related to the grant.
