### **BACKGROUND:**

### **Summary**

The Department requests an additional \$4,885,970 increase to previously submitted estimates for an amended annual budget of \$29,721,112. The amount reflects new state/federal funds through Older Adults' Recovery and Resilience (OARR) funding (Fall Prevention, Senior Legal Services, Family Caregiving Support, and Intergenerational Activities), HCBS Senior Nutrition Infrastructure Grant funding, California Department of Aging Access to Technology funding, additional Area Plan funds, and county department agreements. Resources needed to support service expansion and administration are seven (7) new staff positions at the department.

These additional positions are funded by state funds, all with long-term, multi-year allocations from the Corporation for National and Community Service Retired Senior Volunteer Program; Older Americans Act; and Older Californian's Act.

In addition, the California Legislature has approved funding in support of the Modernizing the Older Californian's Act in the 2022-23 State budget cycle. The planning estimates for these funds, provided recently by the California Department of Aging, allocate a total of \$10,369,738 to Riverside County Office on Aging over the next three fiscal years (FY 22-23 - \$3,052,300; FY 23-24 - \$5,094,011; FY 24-25 - \$2,223,427). These funds will provide additional support for the requested additional staff.

Riverside County Office on Aging (RCOoA) receives federal and state funding to support the provision of services, programs and other activities for older adults and persons with disabilities, in accordance with Title III & Title VII of the Older Americans Act and the Older Californians Act. Countywide services include supportive services at resource centers (IIIB), congregate and home-delivered nutrition (IIIC & NSIP), preventive health and medication management (IIID), family caregiver support (IIIE), long-term care ombudsman services (VII-a), and elder abuse prevention (VII-b).

#### Impact on Residents and Businesses

The additional positions added through this budget adjustment will directly impact residents across the county by expanding department programs to reduce social isolation and improve

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well-being by increasing access to services, and connections and communication with family members, friends, caregivers, healthcare professionals, community resources, and services.
