#### **BACKGROUND:**

This street name change has been requested by the applicant (H.N. and Frances C. Berger Foundation) for PPT200021. The applicant is requesting this street name to be changed from "Delfino Resort Parkway" to "Firebird Way."

PPT200021 is an approved project for the construction of a 295,000 square foot sports and event arena. The Coachella Valley Firebirds professional hockey team will be based and train out of this facility as well, therefore the name change will be fitting for the location.

There are currently no properties addressed with Delfino Resort Parkway as the project associated with Parcel Map 38040 was never developed and completed. GIS addressing has reviewed this request and confirmed that there are no conflicts with the requested name change.

As determined in the attached Notice of Exemption, the name change is exempt from the provisions of CEQA pursuant to Sections 15060(c)(2) and 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines. The name change will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of the categorical exemption and will not cause any direct or indirect physical environmental impacts.

County Counsel has approved resolution Number 2022-166 as to form.

### **Impact on Residents and Businesses**

The applicant owns all but one the properties on the street and this street name change will have no impact on local businesses since the properties were never developed.

#### Additional Fiscal Information

All fees are paid by the applicant. There is no General Fund obligation.

**Exempt Status:** California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, Section 15061(b)(3), General Rule "Common Sense" Exemption. Not a "project" as defined under State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15060(c).

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: Changing the name of a street has been determined to not be a "project" as defined under State CEQA Guidelines section 15060(c). However, even if it was determined to be a project under CEQA for analysis purposes, the project is exempt from the provisions of CEQA specifically by the State CEQA Guidelines as identified below. The renaming of the existing roadway will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the use of the categorical exemption as detailed under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2. The project will not cause any impacts to scenic resources, historic resources, or unique sensitive environments. Further, no unusual circumstances or potential cumulative impacts would occur that may reasonably create an environmental impact. Changing the name of this street will not have an effect on the environment; thus, the County has deemed this does not meet the definition of a "project" under CEQA and no environmental impacts are anticipated to occur.

• Section 15061(b)(3) - General Rule "Common Sense" Exemption. With certainty, there is no possibility that the proposed project may have a significant effect on the environment. The renaming of a street will not require any construction activities, change the use or intensity of the existing site to create a physical environmental impact, and would not lead to any direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical environmental impacts. Therefore, in no way would changing the name of a street have the potential to cause a significant environmental impact and the vacation is exempt from further CEQA analysis.

Section 15060(c) – for purposes of analysis under CEQA, changing the name of a street is
not a "project" under CEQA pursuant to Section 15060(c). An action by a public agency
is only a "project" subject to CEQA if the action might result in a physical change in the
environment. Based upon a review of the whole action undertaken, supported, or
authorized by the County, in no way will changing the name of a street increase the use
of the site, result in increased development or construction impacts, or lead to any direct,
indirect, or cumulative physical environmental impacts.

Based upon the identified exemptions above, the County of Riverside hereby concludes that no physical environmental impacts are anticipated to occur and the project as proposed is exempt under CEQA. No further environmental analysis is warranted.


