

BACKGROUND:

Lakeland Village Line H Project as the Commissioner Christine "Chris" Hyland Stormwater Drainage System

Christine "Chris" Hyland moved to Lake Elsinore in 1989 and became an inspirational force in the community. Chris proudly served as Zone Three Commissioner to the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District from 2007 through 2017 and would regularly meet with residents to discuss flood control issues and inspect District facilities to ensure that the community and District were ready for the winter rainy season. Her advocacy and leadership were instrumental in the realization of the \$5 million Arroyo del Toro project in 2014, which protects the Elsinore Valley Cemetery and portions of State Route 74, and the \$13 million Lakeland Village Line H Project, which provides flood protection for many Lakeland Village residents located between the National Forest foothills and Lake Elsinore roughly between Adelfa Street and Blackwell Blvd. She also guided the District's efforts to develop the Lakeland Village Master Drainage Plan and the design and construction of many additional facilities in the Zone.

Sadly, Christine "Chris" Hyland passed away on July 27, 2019. It is an honor to recognize Commissioner Hyland's service by officially dedicating and naming the Lakeland Village Line H Project as the Commissioner Christine "Chris" Hyland Stormwater Drainage System. A plaque recognizing her contributions will be affixed to the Christine "Chris" Hyland Stormwater Drainage System outlet at the Lake Elsinore beachfront adjacent to Maiden Lane.
