

## ORDINANCE NO. 440.1766 AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 440, RELATING TO SALARIES

This summary is presented pursuant to California Government Code Section 25124(b): a certified copy of the full text of Ordinance No. 440.1766 may be examined at the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, located at 4080 Lemon Street, 1st Floor, Riverside, California.

Ordinance No 440 is a Salary Ordinance that establishes policy and provide administrative procedures related to County employment and compensation and contains terms and conditions of employment for job classes that are temporary or limited term in nature including temporary, and unrepresented Per Diem employees.

The following items were addressed in the update: 1) Revised Section 10 subsection e) to allow the Difficult to Recruit provisions to apply to unrepresented Per Diem employees. The General Provisions of Section 10 subsection b) indicates that the provisions are not applicable to unrepresented Per Diem Employees. Therefore, the Difficult to Recruit provisions would not be applicable this group of employees and/or classifications. Only subsection e) of Section 10 applies to unrepresented Per Diem employees. As such, this subsection was revised to allow the provisions to apply to unrepresented Per Diem employees as reviewed and approved by the Human Resources Director. 2) Revised the Special Adjustments Medical Care Assignments pertaining to differentials applied to Per Diem Psychiatrists. The differentials for these classifications currently only apply to employees who work at the County's Emergency Treatment Services Facility or Inpatient Treatment Facility. Recent updates to the psychiatric services provided at the Riverside University Health System has resulted in the need to have psychiatrists work at the Riverside University Health System -Medical Center. Because the differentials are limited only to staff working at the Emergency Treatment Services or Inpatient Treatment Facilities, Psychiatrists working at the Medical Center are not able to receive the differentials. Therefore, this section was revised to allow Per Diem Psychiatrists who work at the Medical Center to receive the applicable differentials.
