BACKGROUND:

Summary

On May 10, 2022, Item 3.14, the Board of Supervisors (Board) approved the Idyllwild Public Restroom Facility Project (Project) in-principle, found the Project to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15303 – Class 3 New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures Exemption, Section 15311 – Class 11 Accessory Structures Exemption, and Section 15061 (b)(3) "Common Sense" Exemption, and approved the Project budget in the amount of \$450,000, to be funded by the County's Economic Recovery ARPA allocation. The Project will install a public ADA restroom facility and associated sitework to accommodate and encourage travel, tourism and outdoor recreation in Idyllwild, California.

Project plans and specifications have been completed and reviewed by all permitting authorities. The Office of Economic Development (RivCoED) recommends the Board approve plans and specifications and authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise the Notice Inviting Bids.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed Project is expected to enhance the overall welfare of the community through a centralized and ADA accessible public restroom, increasing accessibility and tourist activity to the community of Idyllwild. Tourism affects most sectors of the economy and contributes to sales and transient occupancy tax revenues, jobs, and income.
