

**SUBMITTAL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. CID funding to **Restoration Transitional Supportive Housing (\$2,500.00)** will be used to purchase needed supplies for individuals experiencing homelessness which will include food, transportation, clothing, rental assistance, utilities assistance, identification, and birth certificates.
2. CID funding to **Assistance League of Temecula Valley (\$2,500.00)** will be used for the Operation School Bell (OSB) program which improves the lives of students in SW Riverside County by providing new school clothing to students (TK-12th grade).
3. CID funding to **Corona-Norco Family YMCA (\$2,500.00)** will be used for the **YMCA Fender Music Scholarship** program. With this grant the YMCA will increase music education for children 5 to 17 and will allow them to not turn the youth away for the inability to pay for the music lessons.
4. CID funding to **Corona-Norco Family YMCA (\$5,000.00)** will be used for the YMCA Teen Center Scholarship program at Home Hardens Health & Wellness Center. This program for teens gives them access to homework assistance, recreation programs, computer access to assist with homework, and mentorship program.
5. CID funding to **Transgender Health and Wellness Center (\$1,000)** will be used for the Healing Rainbows project which has a wide range of social services – including linkage to health and mental health care, HIV/AIDS and PrEp education, housing, employment, and other support needs in Riverside County.
6. CID funding to **Vision to Learn (\$4,000.00)** will be used for students K-12 in the highest-need school districts of Riverside County to receive a free screening, eye exam and glasses.
