

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Voices for Children - \$4,000: Funding will be used to support programs that serve children in foster care under the supervision of the Juvenile Dependency Court, to help support them in education, health, and therapeutic services and facilitate visits with their siblings.
2. Rotary Club of Hemet - \$5,000: Funds will be utilized by the Rotary Club of Hemet to support their organization in programs that serve the homeless and assist with food delivery to seniors and send high school students to leadership camps.

3. Moreno Valley Chamber of Commerce - \$5,000: Funding will support various projects and programs that the Chamber has created such as their Military and Governmental Affairs Committee, highlighting and supporting local businesses and collaboration with local school districts.
4. Feeding America - \$8,000: Funding will be used to support on-site and community food distributions to provide accessible food resources to Fifth District residents experiencing food insecurity.
5. Carol's Kitchen - \$10,000: Funds will assist in providing a place for community members to go for a hot and nutritious meal and grocery supplies. Carol's Kitchen also provides clothing and household items and serves over 5,000 free hot meals each month in their kitchens throughout Banning, Beaumont, Cabazon, and San Jacinto.
6. Building Up Lives Foundation - \$3,000: Funding will be used to support programs that meet the needs of the community through free food, clothing, hygiene items, victim services, mental health services, housing, and homeless solutions.
7. Hemet/San Jacinto Chamber of Commerce - \$5,000: Funding will be used to support projects and programs at the Hemet/San Jacinto Valley Chamber of Commerce as they continue to offer support to businesses to enhance their success throughout the community as well as support in outreach and activities for the community and business development.
8. Rising Stars Business Academy - \$10,000: Funds will support projects created by Rising Stars Business Academy such as their Winter Development Program for youth and increase youth engagement and realize their full potential through educational programs and services.
9. RUHS Foundation - \$20,000: Funds will be used to help raise awareness and care for children and families suffering from abuse and neglect and support the critical work at RUHS Pediatric Unit, Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, Pediatric Intensive Care Unit, and Cancer Center.
10. Soroptimist International of Moreno Valley, Inc. - \$2,500: Funding will help support the expansion of the program to March Mountain Alternative Education High School and continue to work with young women to provide career opportunities, overcome barriers and achieve their goals.
11. The FIATM Group Inc. - \$6,000: Funds will support the FIATM Group Inc. in serving youth and families in Moreno Valley, Beaumont, Perris, and Menifee through programs that provide after-school tutoring, mentorship, counseling, and help to deter truancy, drug abuse, gang involvement, and disruptive behavior.
12. Family Service Association - \$4,000: Funding will be utilized to support their annual "Hope for the Holidays" which provides foster children essential items, toiletries and a tote bag for their belongings as well as support food and gifts for families and children in need living in Cabazon and the surrounding communities.
