BACKGROUND:

Summary

Riverside University Health System – Public Health (RUHS-PH) is seeking approval for the purchase of additional lab equipment with COVID-19 Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity (ELC) Enhancing Detection Funding for lab infrastructure (accepted by the Board of Supervisors on September 21, 2021, Item 3.18).

The ELC Enhancing Funds are intended to provide critical resources to local health departments in support of a broad range of COVID-19/SARS-CoV-2 testing and epidemiologic surveillance related activities, including the establishment of modernized public health surveillance systems.

The following capital assets are included in the budget adjustment as detailed in Schedule A:

The equipment is required to perform diagnostic and surveillance testing of SARS-CoV-2 in clinical specimens and wastewater samples.
