BACKGROUND:

<u>Summary</u>

Essential Access Health is contracted by the Federal Government to administer Title X Family Planning funds in California. As a current Title X subrecipient, Riverside University Health System-Public Health (RUHS-PH) receives an annual award to provide basic contraceptive services and teen pregnancy prevention outreach programs through the Family Planning Program. The Family Planning Program provides reproductive health education to the community through collaborative partnerships with Riverside University Health System–Community Health Centers (RUHS-CHC), the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program, schools, and several other community organizations. The Family Planning Program staff offer education on birth control methods, the identification and treatment of sexually transmitted infections and screening for cancers, including testicular cancer. Teen education topics also include other health exams and contraceptive services.

Title X Regulations (42 CFR, part 59.5, subpart A, as revised on October 7, 2021) prohibit federal Title X funds from going to any family planning site that also provides abortion services. Riverside County Family Planning Program services do not promote nor provide abortion as a method of family planning.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Family Planning Program is designed to improve the health status of the community by providing reproductive health services to all residents within the community, with a special focus on reducing the number of teen pregnancies and incidence of sexually transmitted infections among teens. The incidence of sexually transmitted infections remains high, and so has the demand for information and education on these topics within the community. RUHS-PH's goal is to continue providing reproductive health education, clinical linkage, and access to contraceptive methods to teens, foster youth, LGBTQ, college youth and other high-risk populations within the community.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

RUHS-PH Family Planning Program has received Title X funding from Essential Access Health for more than 20 years. Funding is made available through a competitive bid process every three years. The most recent competitive bid was completed in Fiscal Year 2017, data was compiled for organization structure and services Family Planning provides.

On August 30, 2022, Agenda Item 3.68 was approved by the Board of Supervisors to approve Subrecipient Agreement No. 754-5320-71219-22 with Essential Health Access for a total amount of \$150,000 for the period of performance of April 1, 2022 through September 30, 2022. RUHS-PH has received additional funding in the amount of \$150,000 and the period of performance has been extended to March 31, 2023.

SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT NUMBER 754-5320-71219-22 AMENDMENT NUMBER 01

This Amendment No. 1 to the 2022 Subrecipient Agreement for services provided under the Title X Program between Essential Access Health, a California nonprofit corporation ("Essential Access") and County of Riverside Department of Public Health ("Subrecipient") is effective as of October 1, 2022 and is hereby amended as follows. Essential Access and Subrecipient may be referred to collectively as the "Parties" and individually as the "Party."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into that certain 2022 Subrecipient Agreement Number 754-5320-71219-22 on September 21,2022 and effective as of April 1, 2022 through September 30, 2022 ("Subrecipient Agreement");

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to extend the period of performance, increase the amount payable, and add Attachment A-1 and Attachment B-1 to the Subrecipient Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, and the promises and mutual covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth, the Parties agree as follows:

1. The total amount payable by Essential Access is increased by \$150,000 funded by the U.S. Department of Health and Humans Services (DHHS), Office of Population Affairs for the period October 1, 2022 to March 31, 2023.

- 2. The following shall replace Article III: FINANCIAL PROVISIONS, Section A, Amount of Award, Subsection 1 only, in its entirety:
 - 1. In consideration of the services to be delivered by Subrecipient as described in Article II herein, Essential Access shall pay Subrecipient a total amount not to exceed **\$300,000** (the "Title X Award") during the term of this Agreement, provided that funds are available for this purpose under the Grant and Subrecipient is in compliance with all terms and conditions of this Agreement. Subrecipient is only entitled to receive reimbursement for its actual, allowable costs and is not entitled to any payments over and above its actual, allowable cost of operating the Title X program provided for herein, nor any carryover funds at the end of a budget period.
- 3. The following shall replace Article V: Term in its entirety: This Agreement shall be in effect from April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2023, or unless the Agreement is terminated or suspended at an earlier date in accordance with Article X of this Agreement.
- 4. The following Attachments are added to the Subrecipient Agreement attached hereto and incorporated by reference:
 - A. Attachment A-1: Revised Scope of Work
 - B. Attachment B-1: Revised Reporting Requirements
