Greetings.

On February16,2021, I engaged in a 49 min. and 19 second phone call with Carolina Morales about keeping our Resource Family Lisence. The conversation was very informative to find out there was nothing in my file about putting bruises on my granddaughter while she was in our custody. I was not surprised at all considering what this department put me thru. Here is the photo that was in your file of the bruise. Of course all of you missed the fact that Josie is holding a hand gun. You managed to redact her face and yet never noticed that the alledge bruise was reported on the left arm and the photo is of the right. I also requested a hearing on the allegations and was never given that. On September 27,2017, I made an appointment with SB County supervisor Kathrene Barmann about concerns of the children being sexually molested in thier parents home before removal. She refused to investigate it. Cynthia has since gone on social media several times, including an interview with expert Dean Tong, admitting the children were in fact sexually molested in her home and NEVER reported it. With everything you had in YOUR evidence box that I received from your office, and you still didn't feel it was enough to keep these children safe, we will not be keeping our lisence.

The reason for this email is because if anything happens to my grandchildren I will have documentation that everyone included in recieving this was informed about the trauma these children have and continue to endure. The polie have been called on Cymthia at least 3 times since the children were put back in her custody.

Please be assured that you may not have that investigation about the bruises in my file, but I do.

It is a very sad day when people who are mandated by the state to report abuse to this department and DPSS does nothing.

If you should have a problem opening up this photo that was in your evidence box please let me know as I can send it agin. Also please check Cynthia out on Thethe Reality Series: CPS The Horror Stories while she tells the world about how the children were sexually abused before they were removed.

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# Meeting with Mrs. McCray June 5, 2019 9:00am-10:45am

Attendees: Charity Douglas, Mrs. McCray, Gail, Kris

#### Concerns:

#### 1. Safety and Access to Grandchildren

- Ms. McCray stated that "Both parents are involved with drugs and the father has guns, and children are afraid of their father".
- Mrs. McCray stated that San Bernardino Court ordered no contact between Mrs. McCray and her grandchildren. She did get supervised visits which she paid for.
- Domestic violence.
- Grandparents (maternal and paternal) have not seen children in over 7 months.
- Expressed concerned that if children are detained that she will not be considered for placement due to the investigation.

#### 2. Due Process

- Not provided evidence of the allegation or formal written documentation in relation to the substantiation.
- Concerns about the CCL report.
- Ms. McCray stated that her case was "mishandled by both San Bernardino and Riverside Counties".
- Sent several emails to Riverside County and case was not taken seriously.
- Has tried to resolve issues for over a year.

#### 3. Investigation

- Received an anonymous phone call stating that she bruised her granddaughter. Children were in the custody of mother at time of the incident.
- Informed that the worker did not contact the teachers or the counselors during the investigation.
- RFA numbers were incorrect/different.
- Issued a letter based on the CCL findings of a personal rights violation. Corrective action plan
  involves attending a positive discipline class. Expressed that participation would be an
  admission of guilt and that she was not provided with evidence to support the state's
  concerns.

#### **Riverside County Action Items:**

- Facilitate welfare check for grandchildren.
- Follow-up on RFA/CCL timeline and notifications and right to a hearing.
- Provide Mrs. McCray further information related to the hearing and what she can expect.
- Follow-up in relation to case management.

Thank you for your response. I have the entire file of evidence. My concern is about the investigation. I'm very confused about how Ms Fountain was able to complete an investigation without speaking to the people who were involved in the children's lives, teachers, counselors etc. The counselors who saw the children every week and the teachers saw the children 5 days a week, never reported any abuse in our home and are mandated reporters. However, they did report abuse to the social worker, Rose Piccinino, by email. I happen to have those emails. It's also very disturbing that Ms. Fountain never notice a handgun in josie's hand. I'm sure she's well trained at her job but you have to admit this was a very, very questionable investigation. I would like to know how that file of mine that should be in DPSS possession doesn't exist.

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



On February 14,2017 San Bernadino county CPS removed my 2 grandchildren Josie and Ryan Becker from their parents. The entire family, maternal and paternal, were prohibited from having contact with the children before this for many months because the parents didn't want us to know about the drug and weapon activity going on in the house. We still don't know who made the reports but an investigation was opened up in October and the children were removed and placed in my home. My husband and I attended every class, completed all interviews and followed all instruction given to us in order to keep the children in our home. My daughter however didn't follow any court orders and we were threatened with removal of the children because we were not in compliance with reunification with their mother. In November of 2017 I called the State of California to open up an investigation on SB county CPS. Regan Overholt spoke to me for almost an hour and gave me instructions on communication with CPS. Any and all communication was to be done via email. I did just that. Although we followed every instruction for the safety of the children, we have been educated on the fact that CPS does not stand for Child Protective Service. On April 17, 2018 the children went to school and never came back. My daughter was given a 29 day extended visit with the exception of May 6th, an 8 hour visit that was granted to the family. It was the last time we had unsupervised visits with the children. On June 4, 2018 SB county social worker Marina Karlsson came to my home and served me with papers. She verbally accused me of putting bruises on my granddaughter. However there were no written allegations on the paper. The anonymous phone call came in on June 1, 2018, four weeks after we had had any contact with the children. I was informed later that week by 2 Riverside County social workers that the documents were done illegally and falsified. My granddaughter was never interviewed and no photos produced. Then on September 14, 2018 Ronnesha Fountain from the State of California showed up at my home. She is a licensing program analyst with the State of California. She informed me that the state was also investigating me on allegations of abuse. When I asked her for photos of the bruises she informed me that they were in a file in an office that was moving. Her office received a complaint against me on September 6, 2018, four months after we had any unsupervised visits with the children. I spoke with Craig McLaughlin from Riverside County DPSS on September 17, 2018 for almost 1 hour. He informed me that he did know about the investigation. It was his office that moved and that he was looking at my file. In his own words, he said that if there were any photos of any bruises they didn't exist in this universe. He also said that my granddaughter should have been interviewed first. She has never been interviewed and Teri Badiila, Deputy Director of RC DPSS has emailed me there are no photos. I am being investigated for something that, if it happened, it happened in the custody of Cynthia Becker. I was told that SB county closed out the investigation and handed it over to Riverside County. Myrna Miller from RC DPSS, then gave it to the State to investigate. I was never given a report on their findings, which is listed on the paper they gave me that showing me my rights. The harassment we have endured by following the law my is unbelievable and has violated my civil rights. My question is who is protecting the children? If someone put bruises on my granddaughter, why wasn't my daughter questioned and if no one put bruises on my granddaughter why am I under investigation.

Steps I took before I contacted this office

June 4, 2018 emailed Sade Daniels. She is with the State of California. .She never responded. I called her a few days later to ask why she never responded. She said the anonymous phone call to CPS on June 1st never took place.

AND A PROPERTY.

June 8, I called Riverside County CPS hotline and reported the bruises I was accused of doing and gave them my identity. Because SB county wouldn't transfer the case to Riverside they took my info

June 15, 2018 Spoke to Jonathan Byers SB County board of Supervisors

He was supposed to look into this and call me back: never did

did. They sent me a letter telling me to go my local government office. I also contacted the Attorney General's office. They also sent me a letter.

August 3,2018 I went to Yucca Valley for an appointment with Mia Moore, Director of SB county CPS. I took Gayle Chew with me as I've learned never meet with anyone alone. She knew everything about the case except that I was being investigated for putting bruises on Josie. I also produced the illegal and falsified document. She was speechless I emailed her a summery of the meeting hoping to get somewhere with the investigation. She never responded. I emailed her again sometime later and never received any response.

September 11, 2018 Attended a meeting with Robin Reed from Kevin Jeffries office along with my son Spencer McCray. I brought documentation to show that the document was done illegally and falsified.

September 14,2018 Ronnesha Fountain came to my home and gave me papers showing I am under investigation for putting bruises on Josie.

September 17, 2018 Spoke with Craig McLaughlin Riverside County DPSS about the investigation. He acknowledges there are no photos in my file.

September 28,2018 I received a phone message from Teri Badilla, Riverside County Deputy Director of DPSS. It was on my house phone and I left her a message. She called me back on October 2, 2018. She said she would look into my concerns and get back with me. She also confirmed there were no photos.

October 9,2018 I sent 13 certified letters to everyone involved in this case. I received 2 emails back. Teri Badilla and Craig McLaughlin both emailed me back stating there is NO evidence or photos on this investigation. Mia Moore and Kathrene Barmann from SB County called and left messages. I emailed them telling them that I would not be talking on the phone and that all communication would be done via email. They never responded.

As you can see I have tried to take as many steps to resolve this. What I know now is how these poor babies are being slaughtered under the watchful eye of CPS. It is because no one is keeping an eye on CPS. This is by far, not a broken system but a corrupt one.

I would love an explanation on how someone can be investigated for putting bruises on someone when that someone was not in contact with the accused for 4 weeks at the time of the accusation.

Copies of printed material given to the Clerk (by Monday noon deadline) will be provided to each Supervisor. If you have the need to use the overhead "Elmo" projector at the Board meeting, please ensure your material is clear and with proper contrast, notifying the Clerk well ahead of the meeting, of your intent to use the Elmo.

#### **Individual Speaker Limits:**

Individual speakers are limited to a maximum of three (3) minutes. Please step up to the podium when the Chairman calls your name and begin speaking immediately. Pull the microphone to your mouth so that the Board, audience, and audio recording system hear you clearly. Once you start speaking, the "green" podium light will light. The "yellow" light will come on when you have one (1) minute remaining. When you have 30 seconds remaining, the "yellow" light will begin to flash, indicating you must quickly wrap up your comments. Your time is up when the "red" light flashes. The Chairman adheres to a strict three (3) minutes per speaker. Note: If you intend to give your time to a "Group/Organized Presentation", please state so clearly at the very bottom of the reverse side of this form.

# **Group/Organized Presentations:**

Group/organized presentations with more than one (1) speaker will be limited to nine (9) minutes at the Chairman's discretion. The organizer of the presentation will automatically receive the first three (3) minutes, with the remaining six (6) minutes relinquished by other speakers, as requested by them on a completed "Request to Speak" form, and clearly indicated at the bottom of the form.

# Addressing the Board & Acknowledgement by Chairman:

The Chairman will determine what order the speakers will address the Board, and will call on all speakers in pairs. The first speaker should immediately step to the podium and begin addressing the Board. The second speaker should take up a position in one of the chamber aisles in order to quickly step up to the podium after the preceding speaker. This is to afford an efficient and timely Board meeting, giving all attendees the opportunity to make their case. Speakers are prohibited from making personal attacks, and/or using coarse, crude, profane or vulgar language while speaking to the Board members, staff, the general public and/or meeting participants. Such behavior, at the discretion of the Board Chairman, may result in removal from the Board Chambers by Sheriff Deputies.
